AN ORDINANCE FOR THE VACATION
OF AN EAST-WEST ALLEY WHICH RUNS
SOUTH OF LOTS ONE AND TWO AND
NORTH OF LOT THREE IN THE ABLE

WESTFIELD, INDIANA

BE IT RESEOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WESTFIELD, INDIANA, UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE LAW OF THE STATE OF INDIANA, DULY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THAT STATE:

SECTION I. WHEREAS the owners of Lot Three in the Able Doan's Addition to the town of Westfield, Indiana have heretofore filed their Petition for the Vacation of a certain alley which is described as follows, to-wit:

An alley in the Able Doan's Addition to the town of Westfield, Indiana, which runs South of Lots One and Two and North of Lot Three in the said Addition to the town of Westfield, which alley is sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) feet in width and one hundred sixty-five (165) feet in length, and

WHEREAS notice of the said Petition for Vacation has been given according to the law, to the general public and to the owners of all the lots which will most injuriously or benefically be effected by said vacation, and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the town of Westfield being duly advised finds that for the best interest of the general public, the town of Westfield, Indiana, and all the adjoining land owners, the alley heretofore described should be vacated and there being no valid objections against the said vacation.

SECTION II. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the town of Westfield Indiana, in their regular session, does now take final action upon and with respect to the said Petition for the Vacation of an alley filed by the owners of Lot Three, Phillip Montgomery and Delsie Montgomery, for the vacation of the above-described alley, and it is now moved and seconded and by unanimous vote of the Board of Trustees of the town of Westfield, Indiana, the said Petition for the Vacation of an Alley is now approved, confirmed, and ratified by this said Board of Trustees of the town of Westfield, Indiana this 8th day of June, 1970,

and the alley heretofore described in this ordinance is hereby vacated.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect forthwith.
