



The undersigned, Postmen Service Corp., by Howard V. Bishop, President, and Robert L. Bush, Asst. Secretary, being the owners of the above described real estate, do hereby lay off, plot and subdivide the same into lots and streets, to commence with:

1. The streets above and not heretofore dedicated are hereby dedicated to the public.
2. All numbered lots in 191 Addition shall be developed in residential lots, and one single family with accessory building and not exceeding two stories in height may be erected or maintained on said lots.
3. All trees above ground and over 6 inches in diameter at the point where they stand, shall be planted or permitted to remain on any corner lot within the triangular area formed by the intersection of a street line with the edge of a city, permanent, or temporary line. No tree shall be permitted to remain within such distance of such intersection unless the owner has given written notice to the authority of Marion County, Indiana, and to the owners herein referred to, not including transportation companies, for the installation of telephone and wires in the addition, however, shall take their title subject to the rights of the public utility and to the owners herein referred to, no permanent or other structures shall be erected without being removed to show any damage or any hazard to any such owner or owners by or through any such violation of their rights and easements. The Postmen Service Corporation, their successors, or assigns who shall be entitled to such or the owners by judgment or otherwise shall have a right to sue for damages for any such violation. Such provisions shall be a full force and effect until January 1, 1967, at which time the covenants, restrictions and reservations shall be voided in whole or in part. Invalidation of any
