
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

The undersigned, LUMBER MART, INC., by M. II, Slooson, President, and Oliver R. Hughey, Secretary, owners of the real estate shown and described herein, do hereby certify that we have laid off, platted and divided! and do hereby lay off, plat and subdivide, said real estate to accordance with the within plat. The following restrictions. Himitations, and covenants are hereby imposed upon and shall run with the land contained in such plat.

This subdivision shall be known and designated as BROOKSHIRE, a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. All streets and alleys shown and not heretofore dedicated, are hereby dedicated to the public.

Front and side yard building setuack lines are hereby established as shown on this plat, between which lines and the property lines of the street, there shall be erected or maintaines no building or otructure.

There are strips of ground as shown on this plat and marked Drainage and Utility Essement, reserved for the two of public utilities for the installation of water and sawer mains, poles, ducts. Hase and wires, subject at all times to the proper authorities and to the essement herein reserved. No permanent or other structures are to be erected or maintained upon real datrips of land, but owners of lots in this subdivision shall take their titles subject to the rights of the public utilities.

All into in this subdivision are reserved for residential use, and no building other than a one family resident or structure or facility accessory in use thereto shall be exected thereon.

Not more than one building shall be erected or used for residential purposes on key lot in this subdivision.

The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open porches and garages, shall be not less than lowercon hundred (1400) square feel in the case of a one-story structure, nor less than one thousand (1600) square feet in the case of a smalltple story structure, provided no structure of more than one story shall have less than an aggregate of one thousand eight hundred (1600) aquare feet of finished and liveable floor area. All garages shall be attached to the residence dwelling and be a minimum of two car size.

No truther, tent, shack, attuched shed, basement, garage, barn or other outhuilding or temporary structure shall be used for temporary or permanent realdance on any lot in this subdivision. An attached garage, tool shed, or detached staruge building erected or used as an accessory to a residence in this subdivision shall be of a permanent type of construction and conform to the general architectural and appearance of such residence.

No rences shall be erected in this subdivision between the building lines and the property lines of the affects as shown on the within plat, except with approval of the fumber Mart, inc., which sences shall not exceed 42 inches in height and shall be of a decorable nature.

No building, structure or accessory building shall be erected closer to the side of any lot than 10 fest, however, any proposed sensitiveness closer than 15 feet to the side of any lot must be approved by Lumber Mari, Inc. Where buildings are rected on more than one single in this restriction shall apply to the side times of the extreme boundaries of the multiple lots.

less t - 2 - 2, and 72 shall gain access from Brookphire Parkway and Windoor Drive only. Driveways onto 126th Street from these lots will not be permitted, and the buildings on said lots shall fees the interior streets.

No structure in this subdivision without special approval from Lumber Mart. Inc. shall exceed 2 1/2 stories or 25 feel to height measured from flatsh grade to the under side of eave line, and no structure other than an open porch shall be erected between the building line as designated on the plat and the property line of the street.

No bust, trailer or camper of any kind (including but ast-in limitation thereof, house trailers, campin trailers or hout trailers), or any disabled which shall be kept or parked upon anid lot except within a gar other approved strature.

All lot owners will be required to insiall, or have installed, at least one gas or electric "duck to dawn" yard light in the front.

No building shall be erected, placed or altered on any building plot in this subdivision until the building plans, specifications and plot plan showing the location of such building have been approved as to the conformity and harmony of external design with existing structures herein and as to the building with respect to topography and finished ground elevation, by Lumber Mart. inc. owners of the herein described real estate, or by their duly authorized representatives. If the Lumber Mart, inc. falls to act upon any plans submitted to it for its approval within a period of lifteen its days term the submission date of the same, the owner may proceed then with the building according to the plans as approved. Neither the Lumber Mart, inc. nor the designated representatives shall be calified to any compensation for services performed pursuant to this covenant.
