DECLARATION OF COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS

COVENTRY RIDGE

Section Five

COVENTRY RIDGE, LTD., an Indiana limited partnership ("Developer"), has executed this Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions ("Declaration") this 8th day of December, 1987, for the purpose of (i) establishing minimum standards pertaining to the development, use and maintenance of certain real estate in Boone County, Indiana, described in Exhibit & attached hereto, incorporated herein and referred to herein as "Coventry Ridge - Section Five" and (ii) preserving and enhancing the property values in Coventry Ridge - Section Five; and by such execution, Developer as the owner of Coventry Ridge Section Five declares that the standards, covenants and restrictions contained in this Declaration shall be imposed on, apply to and run with the real estate described in Exhibit A and shall inure to the benefit of and be a charge upon the owners and occupants of such real estate.

The plat of the real estate described in Exhibit A has been recorded in Plat Book 6, pages 86 - 87 in the Office of the Recorder of Boone County, Indiana, and all references herein to the "Plat" are to such recorded plat.

References to "Coventry Ridge" herein are to the real estate described in $\underline{\text{Exhibit B}}$ attached hereto and incorporated herein.

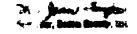
The following standards, covenants and restrictions are established for Coventry Ridge - Section Five:

- 1. Land Use. Lots may be used only for residential purposes and only one single-family dwelling not to exceed two and one-half stories or 25 feet in height measured from finish grade to the underside of the eve line, a private garage and other such outbuildings usual and incidental to the use of a residential lot may be constructed thereon. No portion of any lot may be sold or subdivided such that there will be thereby a greater number of houses in Coventry Ridge Section Five than the number of original lots shown on the Plat. Notwithstanding any provision in the applicable zoning ordinance to the contrary, no lot may be used for any "Special Use" that is not clearly incidental and accessory to single family dwellings. No home occupation shall be conducted or maintained on any lot other than one which does not constitute a "special use" and is incidental to a business, profession or occupation of the owner or occupant of such lot and which is generally or regularly conducted at another location which is away from such lot. No signs of any nature, kind or description shall be erected, placed, or permitted to remain on any lot advertising a permit ted home occupation.
- 2. <u>Building Control</u>. Prior to construction of any structure upon a lot, or the reconstruction, remodeling or alteration thereof if the exterior elevation will be affected thereby, a Lot Development Plan and any other data or information that may be requested, must be submitted to the building committee of Coventry Ridge (the "Building Committee") for its approval, said approval to be evidenced by a written instrument executed by a majority of the Building Committee and delivered to the person or persons requesting such approval. No improvements, alterations, repairs, excavations, changes in grade or other work that in any way alters the grade or elevation of the record.

The purposes of this Declaration, "Lot Development Plan" can including site storm drainage and grading plans, (ii) building plans, including elevation and floor plans, (iii) material plans, including elevation and floor plans, (iii) material plans and specifications, (iv) landscaping plan, and iversepect to the improvement of a lot or the construction alteration of a structure or improvement thereon.

3. <u>Building Committee</u>. The Building Committee sna. consist of three (3) members who shall be appointed from time to time by Developer except as otherwise provided herein. From and after the date upon which the last lot in Coventry Ridge sold by Developer, its successor or assigns, all members of members of members of including Committee shall be elected annually by owners of including Coventry Ridge in such manner as such owners among them selves may determine. A majority of the members of the Building Committee constitutes a quorum for the transaction of building Committee constitutes a quorum for the transaction of buildings and the decision of a majority is controlling and final.

The Building Committee shall have the power to regulate in external design, appearance, use and location of all structural and other improvements upon a lot in such manner as to preserve and enhance values in Coventry Ridge and to maintain a marmon ious relationship among structures, improvements and the natural regetation and topography, and is authorized to determine whether the proposed structures and other improvement conform and are harmonious in external design with existing structures, whether the building and property set-back lines are in conformity with applicable plat requirements, and whether the proposed site storm drainage plan conforms to improve and lot drainage plan as specified in the approved final construction plans for Coventry Ridge - Section Five. It shall also undertake such other duties and responsibilities as are assigned to it herein. No charge will be made to any purchaser of a lot for examination of plans or for giving approval for construction thereon. In the event the Building Committee does not indicate in writing its approval disapproval of plans submitted for its review within a permit of fifteen (15) days after submission, the Building Committee is deemed to have disapproved such plans.

No member of the Building Committee shall have any liability to any lot owner with respect to the exercise or not exercise of his duties hereunder. The Building Committee shall have no duty to enforce the previsions of this Declaration to seek compliance with the terms hereof.

4. <u>Dwelling Size</u>. Except as otherwise provided herein no residence may be constructed, arected or maintained on any lot in Coventry Ridge - Section Five, or any other section of Coventry Ridge, having a ground floor area, exclusive of open porches, attached garages and basements, of less than 1.80 square feet in case of a one story residence, or less than 1.100 square feet in case of a one and one-half or two or call and one-half story residence.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Developer may, in its fettered discretion, designate a maximum of seventeen (17) in Coventry Ridge upon which a residence may be construct. having a ground floor area, exclusive of open porches, attach garages and basements, of 1,500 square feet if a one-structure, or 900 square feet if a higher structure but in the case of a building higher than one story, there must also be least 600 feet in addition to the ground floor area.

- 5. Temporary Structures. No trailer, shack, tent, but basement, garage or other outbuilding may be used at any time as a residence, temporary or permanent, nor may any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.
- 6. Building Location and Finished Floor Elevation. building may be erected between the building set-hack lime shown on the Plats and the lot lines; and no structure or pathereof may be built or erected nearer than 10 feet, or 10% the actual lot width to 25 feet, whichever is greater, to a side yard line or nearer than 25 feet to any rear lot lime. Where buildings are erected on more than one single lot, the restriction shall apply to the side lines of the extreme boundaries of the multiple lots. A minimum finished floor elevation, shown on the development plan for Coventry Ridge Section Five, is hereby established for each lot and finished floor with the exception of flood protected basement shall be constructed lower than said minimum without the written consent of the Building Committee. Demonstration of adquate storm water drainage with both on-lot and overall proper drainage plans shall be a prime requisite of alternatifinished floor elevations. Before building commences, a finished floor grade shall be physically checked on the lot and certified by a licensel professional engineer or a licensel land surveyor.
- 7. Building Completion. Unless a delay is caused a strikes, war, court injunction or acts of God, the exterior any dwelling or structure built upon any lot shall be completed within one (1) year after the date of commencement of the building process; and if not completed within such time, the the Building Committee may re-enter, take possession of sall lot, without notice, and sell the same together with improvements, and after payment of liens and expenses, pay the balance of the sale proceeds to the owner of said lot at the time as all sale.
- 8. Easements. Lots are subject to easements for drainage, sanitary sewers and other utilities and access as shown the Plat and marked "D.R.", "U.E." or "D. & U.F.", as applicable, which are reserved for the use of lot owners, the owner from time to time of any other portions of the real estat located in Coventry Ridge, public utility companies and governmental agencies for one or more of the following purposes: (a to provide paths and courses for area and local storm drainage either overland or in adequate underground conduit, to serve the needs of the subdivision and adjoining ground and/or public drainage systems; and it shall be the individual responsibility of each land owner to maintain the drainage across his continuated to the construction or reconstruction of any in provement, nor shall any grading restrict, in any manner, in waterflow. Said areas are subject to construction or reconstruction to any extent necessary to obtain adequate drainage at any time by any governmental authority having jurisdiction over drainage or by Leveloper, but Developer shall not have an duty to undertake any such construction or reconstruction. Said easements are for the mutual use and benefit of the owner of all lots in Coventry Ridge. The owner of each lot, to

acceptance of a deed thereto, shall be deemed to have consented to the temporary storage (detention) of storm water within the drainage easements located on such owner's lot. (b) for the use of the local governmental agency having jurisdiction over the storm and sanitary waste disposal system designed to serve Coventry Ridge and adjacent areas for the purpose of installing to an admintenance of sewers that are a part of said system to for the use of all public utility companies, not include transportation companies, for the installation and maintenance is mains, ducts, poles, lines and wires, as well as for all uses specified in the case of sever easements. Without the written consent of Developer or the Building Committee, no structure or other improvement, including fences, patios or decks, shall be built on any drainage cross easements which abut dedicated public rights-of-way.

- Driveways. All driveways shall be paved and main tained dust free.
- 10. <u>Vehicle Parking</u>. No camper, motor home, truck, trailer, boat or disabled vehicle ray be parked or stored overnight or longer on any lot in open public view.
- 11. Signs. Except for such signs as Developer may in its absolute discretion display in connection with the development of Coventry Ridge and the sale of lots therein and such signs identifying the subdivision as may be located on an entry sign easement, no sign of any kind shall be displayed to the public view of any lot except that one sign of not more than two (2) square feet may be displayed on a lot at any time for the purpose of advertising the property for sale or for rent, or may be displayed by a builder to advertise the property during construction and sale.
- planting higher than eighteen (18) inches shall be permitted between the front property line and the front building set-back line except a planting which is part of the house landscaping the prime root of which is within four (4) feet of the house No chain link fance shall be installed on any lot if it would be visible from a public street. No fence shall be erected or any lot line and any fence along, but inside the property line shall be subject to approval by the Building Committee. All fences shall be kept in good repair and erected reasonably so as to enclose the property and decorate the same without hinderance or obstruction to any other property. No fence, wall hedge or shrub planting which obstructs sight lines at elevations netween two (2) and six (6) feet above the street shall be placed or permitted to remain on any corner lot within the triangular area formed by the street property lines and a liconnecting points 25 feet from the intersection of said street lines, or in the case of a street line with the edge of driveway pavement or alley line. No tree shall be permitted to remain within such distances of such intersections unless the followed the sight lines. Sufficient height to premote obstruction of such sight lines.

- 13. <u>Vegetation</u>. Lot owners shall not permit the growth of weeds and volunteer trees and bushes, and shall keep their lot reasonably clear from such unsightly growth at all times. any owner fails to comply with this requirement, the Buildin. Committee may cause the weeds to be cut and the lot cleared on such growth at the expense of the lot owner, and the Buildin Committee shall have a lien against the lot for the expensations.
- 14. <u>Nuisances</u>. No noxicus or offensive activity shall recarried on upon any lot nor shall anything be done thereon which may be, or may become, as annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood. Barking dogs shall constitute a nuisance.
- 15. Garbage and Refuse Disposal. No lot shall be used of maintained as a dumping ground for trash. Rubbish, garbage of other waste shall be kept in sanitary containers out of publiview. All equipment for storage or disposal of such materials shall be kept clean and sanitary. Trash, leaves and the refuse shall not be burned except in acceptable incinerators and in compliance with all applicable legal requirements.
- 16. Livestock and Poultry. No animals, livestock of poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any lot except that dogs, cats or other household pets may be kept provided that they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose. The owners of such permitted pets shall confine them to their respective lots such that they will not be a nuisance. Owners of dogs shall so concrol or confine them so as to avoid barking which will annoy or disturb adjoining lot owners.
- 17. Storage Tanks. Any gas or oil storage tanks used in connection with a lot shall be either buried or located in the garage or house such that they are completely concealed from public view.
- 18. Mailboxes. All mailboxes installed at the street to service lots in Coventry Ridge Section Five shall be uniform and shall be of a type, color and manufacture approved by the Building Committee. Such mailboxes shall be installed upon posts approved as to type, size and location by the Building Committee.
- 19. Septic Systems. No septic tank, absorption field any other on-site sewage disposal system (other than a lateral main connected to a strittery sewerage collection system operated by the Town of Ziensville or a successor public agency or public utility) shall be installed or maintained on any lot.
- 20. Water Systems. No private or semi-private water supply system may be located upon any lot which is not in compliance with regulations or procedures adopted or established by the Indiana State Board of Health, or other civil authority having jurisdiction. To the extent that domestic water service is available from a water line located within 200 feet of the lot line maintained by the Town of Zionsville or a public or private utility company, each lot owner shall connect to such water line to provide water for domestic use on the lot and shall pay all connection, availability or other charges lawfully established with respect to connections thereto.
- 21. <u>Drainage</u>. In the event storm water drainage from any lot or lots flows across another lot, provision shall be made by the owner of such lot to permit such drainage to continue, without restriction or reduction, across the downstream lot and into the natural drainage channel or course, although no specific drainage easement for such flow of water is provided on

the Plat. To the extent not maintained by the Boone Count. Drainage Board, "Drainage Easements" reserved as drainage swales shall be maintained by the owner of the lot upon which such easements are located such that water from any adjacent lot shall have adequate drainage along such swale. All lot within Coventry Ridge are included in the Clarkston Legal Drain which was established by the Boone County Drainage Board Laugust, 1980, and each lot in Coventry Ridge is subject that assessment for the costs of maintenance of storm sewers located in Coventry Ridge, which assessment is a lien against the lot the elevation of a lot shall not be changed so as to after materially the surface elevation or grade of surrounding lotts Perimeter foundation drains, sump pump drains, downshouts and water softener drains shall not be outletted into the subdivision streets or street right-of-way. These drains shall be connected whenever feasible into a subsurface drainage title Each owner shall maintain the subsurface drains and title located on his lot and shall be liable for the cost of all repairs thereto or replacements thereof.

- 22. Antennas and Receivers. No satellite receiver and downlink shall be permitted on any lot, not shall any external antenna be permitted thereon without the prior written consent of the Building Committee.
- 23. Exterior Lights. No exterior light shall be erected or maintained between the building line and rear lot line so as to shine or reflect directly upon another lot. If street lights are not installed in Coventry Ridge Section Five, then each owner shall install and maintain a light in operable condition on his lot at a location, having a height and of a type style and manufacture approved by Developer prior to the installation thereof. Each such light fixture shall also have bulb of a maximum wattage approved by Developer to insuruniform illumination on each lot and shall be equipped with photo electric cell or similar device to insure automaticillumination from dusk to dawn each day.
- 24. Electric Bug Killers. Electric bug killers, "zappers" and other similar devices shall not be installed at a location or locations which will result in the operation thereof becoming a nuisance or annoyance to other lot owners and shall only be operated when outside activities require the use thereof and not continuously.
- 25. Assessments. The Building Committee may make assessments to cover any costs incurred in enforcing these covenant or in undertaking any maintenance or other activity which the responsibility of the Building Committee or of a lot owned who has failed to perform such responsibility as required here under. Any assessment resulting from the failure of P lot owner to comply with the requirements of these covenants of these covenants of these covenants of action to enforce these covenants or the undertaking of the maintenance or other activity.
- 26. Lien for Assessments. Each owner of a lot by a captance of a deed thereto, whether or not it shall be so expressed in such deed, is deemed to covenant and agree to passessments as the same become due in the manner herein provided. All such assessments, together with interest thereo, and costs of collection thereof as herein provided, shall be charge on the land and shall be a continuing lien upon the regainst which each such assessment is made until paid in full such assessments shall also be the personal obligation of the owner of the lot at the time when the assessment became due an payable. Any assessment not paid within thirty (30) days after.

the date the same became due and payable shall bear interest from the due date at a percentage rate not greater than eighteen percent (18%) per annum to be established by the Building Committee. The Building Committee or any member thereof shall be entitled to institute in any court of competent jurisdiction such procedures, at law or in equity, by foreclosure or otherwise, to collect the delinquent assessment plus any expenses or costs, including attorneys' fees, incurred by the Building Committee or such member in collecting the same. If the Building Committee has provided for collection of any assessment in installments, upon default in the payment or any one or more installments, the Building Committee may acceptante payment and declare the entire balance of said assessment due and payable in full. No owner may waive or otherwise escape liability for the assessments provided for herein by abandonment of his lot or otherwise.

The lien of the assessments provided for herein shall be subordinate to the lien of any recorded first mortgage covering such lot and to any valid tax or special assessment lien on such lot in favor of any governmental taxing or assessing authority. Sale or transfer of any lot shall not affect the assessment lien. The sale or transfer of any lot pursuant the mortgage foreclosure or any proceeding in lieu thereof shall however, extinguish the lien of such assessments as to payment which became due prior to such sale or transfer. No take transfer shall relieve such lot from liability for any interments which thereafter become due or from the lien thereof.

The Building Committee shall, upon demand, at any the furnish a certificate in writing signed by a member of the Building Committee that the assessments on a lot have been pain or that certain assessments remain unhaid, as the case may be such certificates shall be conclusive evidence of payment any assessment therein stated to have been paid.

Any easement granted herein or any property shown on the Plat as dedicated and intended for acceptance by the local public authority and devoted for public use shall be exempted from the assessments, charge and lien created herein.

- 27. Annexation. Each owner of a lot in Coventry Ridge, to the acceptance of a deed thereto, shall be deemed to have waived such owner's right to remonstrate against annexation of all or any portion of Coventry Ridge by the Town of Zionsville at any time after the earlier of December 31, 1988, or the date that Developer has conveyed all lots in Coventry Ridge to unaffiliated purchasers in the ordinary course of pusiness.
- 28. Owners Association. Developer at any time, or the owners of a majority of the lots in Coventry Ridge at such time as Developer no longer owns (i) any part of the land described in Exhibit B or (ii) any lot in Coventry Ridge, may establish not-for-profit corporation to be known as "Coventry Ridge Homeowners Association, Inc." (the "Association"). The Articles of Incorporation of the Association (the "Articles") shall provide that each owner of a lot in Coventry Ridge shall automatically be a member of the Association as long as he/she as an owner of a lot and that each lot shall have appurtenant thereto one clavote that may be cast by the owners of such lot on all matters upon which members of the Association may vote, including the election of the members of the Board of Directors of the Association (the "Board"). The Articles may provide that the members of the Building Committee shall be elected by the members of the Association or by the Board and that the powers of the Building Committee shall be exercised by the Board which in such event, shall for the purposes of this Declaration in deemed to be the Building Committee. The Articles may vest

,--

the Association such further powers as are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Declaration and are in furtherance of its purposes.

- 29. Block A. Block A as shown on the Plat is devoted in use in connection with the sewerage treatment plant located of the parcel within Block A denoted on the Plat as "Exception." The sewer easements (S.E.) shown on Block A are intended to provide means for the drainage of sewerage to and from the treatment plant. The access easements shown on Block A are intended to intended to afford the Town of Zionsville and any successor owner of the treatment plant and the ancillary sewer facilities located on Block A. The access easement located on Lot 121 is limited to use by the Town of Zionsville and any successor owner of the treatment plant for ingress and egress to and from Block A. Developer intends to convey Brock A to the Town of Zionsville. If, however, it does not do so, then Block A are the facilities located thereon shall be maintained by the Building Committee and all costs associated with the maintendance of Block A, including real estate taxes and assessment thereon, shall be allocated pro-rata among all Lots in Coventrating and the Building Committee shall make and collect assessments therefor in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 25 hereof.
- 30. Enforcement. The right to enforce each of the tore going restrictions by injunction, together with the right is cause the removal by due process of law of structures erected or maintained in violation thereof, is reserved to Developer the Building Committee and the owners of the lots in Coventry Ridge Section Five, their heirs and assigns, who are entitled to such relief without being required to show any damage of any kind to Developer, the Building Committee or any owner or owners by or through any such violation or attempted violation. The Boone County Building Inspector, members of the Building Committee, principals and agents of Developer and others delegated to do so by Developer shall have the right to go upon any lot within Coventry Ridge without being a trespasser to inspect any work being performed thereon to assure compliance with this Declaration and conformity with lot development plans and with any other plans or submittals made to the Building Inspector the Building Committee or Developer upon which approvals required by this Declaration were or are to be based. Neither the Building Committee nor the Developer shall be liable for damages of any kind to any person or entity for failure to abile by, enforce or carry out any provision or provisions of this Declaration. There shall be no rights of reversion or for feiture of title resulting from any violations.
- 31. Severability. Invalidation of any of these covenant, and restrictions or any part thereof by judgment or court order shall not affect or render the remainder of said covenants are restrictions invalid or inoperative.
- 32. Non-Liability of Developer. Developer shall not have any liability to a lot owner or to any other person or entity with respect to drainage on, over or under a lot. Such drain age shall be the responsibility of the owner of the lot upon which a residence is constructed and of the builder of such residence; and an owner, by an acceptance of a deed to a lot shall be deemed to agree to indemnify and hold Developer free and harmless from and against any and all liability arising from, related to, or in connection with drainage on, over an under the lot described in such deed. Developer shall have a duties, obligations or liabilities hereunder except such as agreey assumed by Developer, and no duty of, or warranty by Developer shall be implied by or inferred from any term to provision of this Declaration.

33. General Provisions. This Declaration may be amended (a) prior to December 31, 1990, by Developer acting alone and (b) at any time by the owners of at least two-thirds of the lots in Coventry Ridge which includes not less than a majority of the owners of lots in Coventry Ridge - Section Five; provided, however, that no amendment which would alter the powers of the Building Committee or the method of designating the members shall be effective unless approved in writing the members shall be effective unless approved in writing or any part of the land described in Exhibit B. Each such amendment must be evidenced by written instrument signed and acknowledged by Developer or the owner or owners conclaining therein, setting forth facts sufficient to indicate compliance with this paragraph, and recorded in the Boone County Recorder's Office.

Except as the same may be amended from time to time, the foregoing restrictions will be in full force and effect until December 31, 2006, at which time they will be automatically extended for successive periods of ten years, unless by a vote of the majority of the then owners it is agreed that these Covenants shall terminate in whole or in part.

As used herein, the term "lot" means a lot depicted on the Plat.
