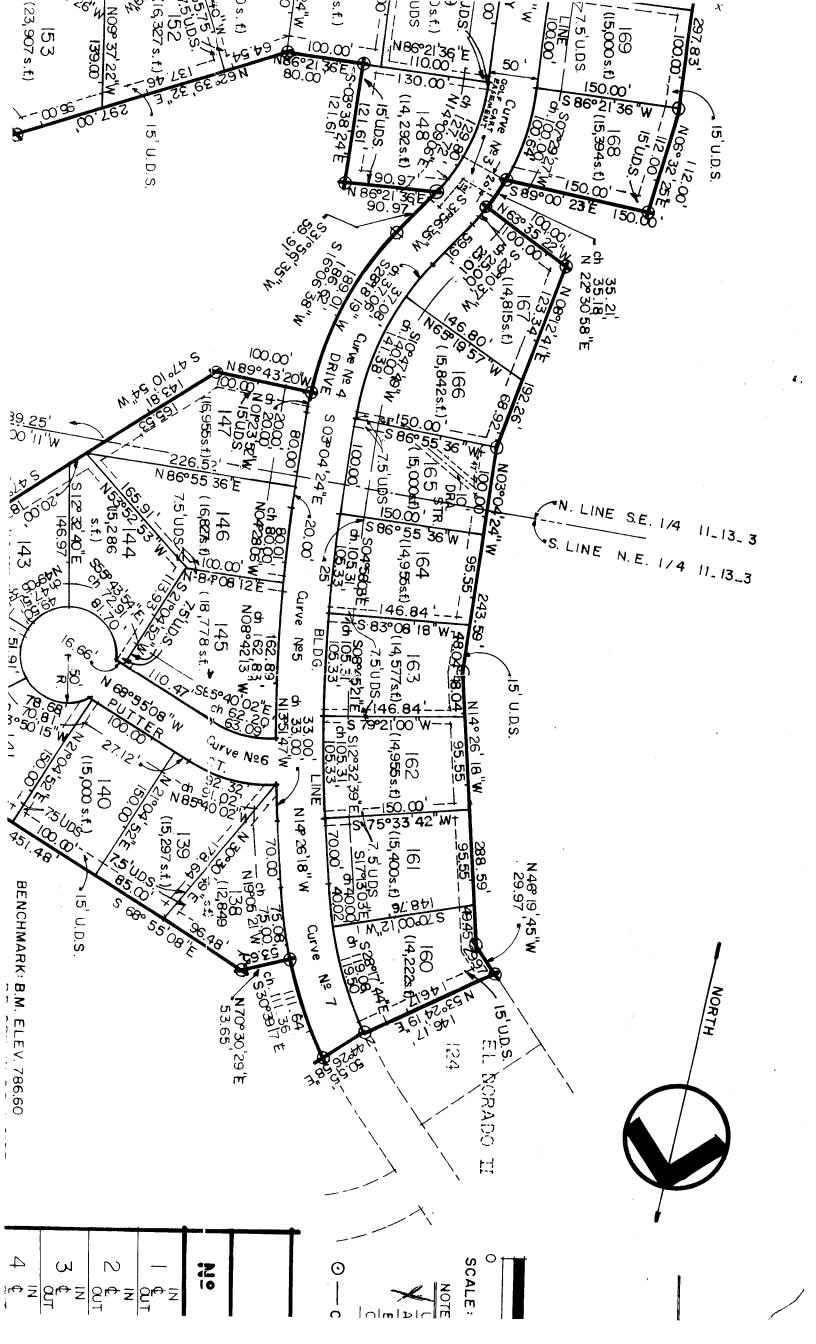
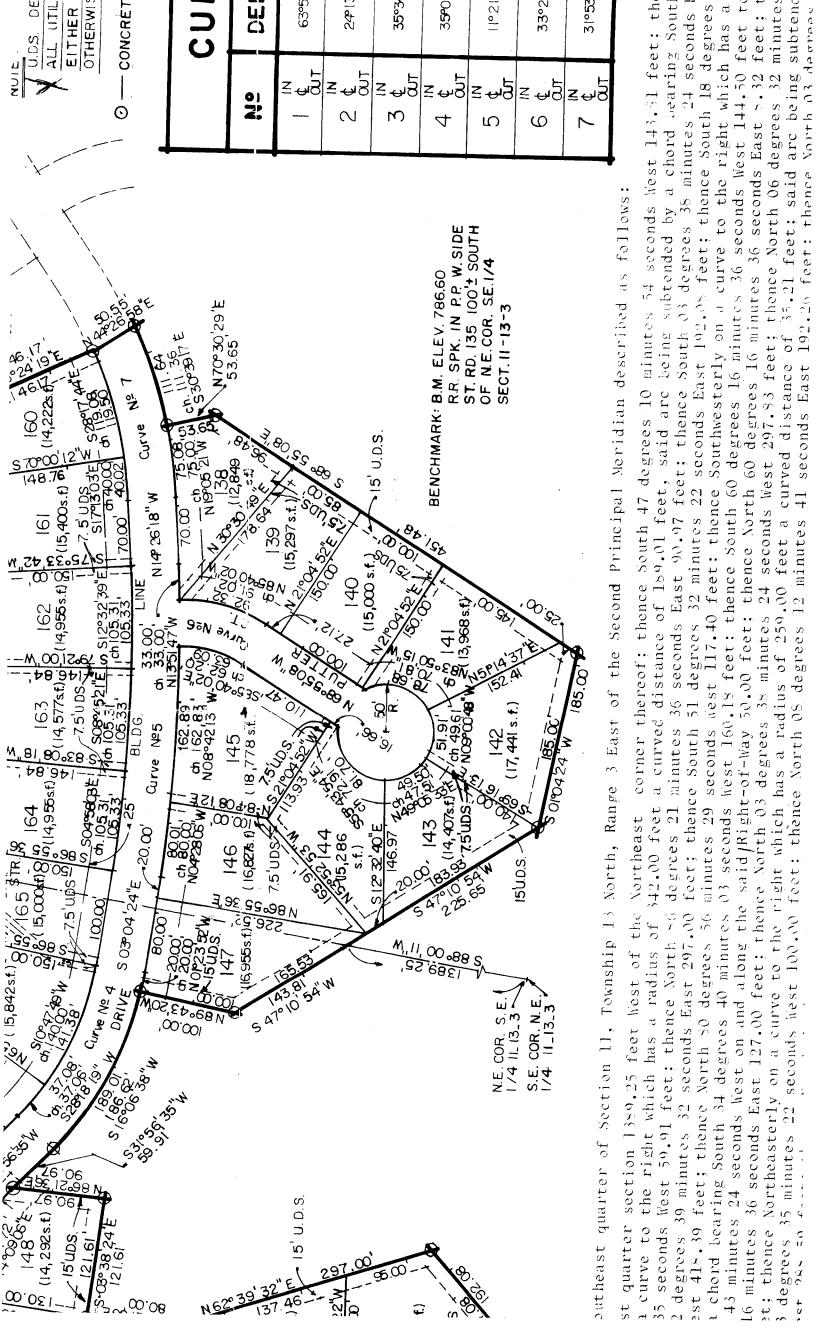

ire itectural Control Committee is composed of three members, appointed the developer. A majority of the committee may designate a representative to act for it. In the event of death or resignation of any member of the Committee the remaining members shall have full authority to designate a successor.

(A) This aforementioned Architectural Control Committee may be elected by the majority of the lot owners when the following steps have been taken: (1) Notice is served upon the Architectural Control Committee that an election has been requested, said notice being signed by fifty percent of the fee title owners of the lots in this subdivision. (2) Nominations for said committee must be made in writing to the Architectural Control Committee and said nominations must be signed by at least ten percent of the fee title owners, each lot having one vote, nominations will be closed after thirty days notice has been served upon the Architectural Control Committee. The election will then be held at the time and place selected by the Architectural Control Committee, ballots shall be east in writing and one vote will be east for each lot in the subdivision.

(B) All drives into these lots shall be hard surfaced and constructed in a manner befitting the other lots in the neighborhood. Said decision and judgement or construction and maintenance of these drives shall be under the control of the Architectural Control Committee.

The Architectural Control Committee approval or disapproval as required in these and 8. covenants shall be in writing. - 10. No sign of any hind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot except one professional sign of not more than one squere foot, one sign of not more than fiv: square feet advertising the property for sale or rent, or signs used by a builder to advertise the property during the construction and
- 11. No oil drilling, oil development operations, oil refining, quarrying or mining operation of any kind small be permitted apon or in any lot, nor shall oil wells, tands, tunnels, mineral excavations or shafts be permitted apon or in any lot. No derrick or other structure designed for use in horing for oil or natural gas shall be erected, maintained, or permitted apon any lot.
