



Outline sketch of the building

Three lots as laid down in the annexed Plat are bounded on the West by Alley east of lots No. 47, 48, 49 & 50 in the original plat of said town, on the South by the North side of Monroe street, on the North by the South side of Jefferson street, on the East by such line as will, exclusive of Mechanic street include the said eight lots of the same quantity in size as to the lots in said town to wit: Seven-hundred feet by One hundred & forty-four acres including alley between said lots - Each lot twelve feet wide, street & sixty feet wide.

Know all men by these presents, that George King of the County of Johnson and State of Indiana have laid off to the Town of Franklin aforesaid Addition No. 2. In two as above described containing Eight-lots the street and alley hereby are made public property and I do relinquish all right individually to the same to the lots as marked. I do retain all right of disposition.

This is to certify that we, Jessie Beard and Hildrey Sticks have laid off an addition to the Town of Franklin in the County of Johnson and State of Indiana of which on the left hand margin is a correct plat except that portions inclosed in the lines marked number one, that said addition is called and known as addition number five laid off in the said Town of Franklin by said Jessie Beard and Hildrey Sticks and is bounded as follows: Commencing on the North side thereof Seventy-Two feet East of the east side of the alley on the East side of the Original Town Standard; thence running North $2\frac{1}{2}$ E. to the Depot Ground belonging to the Madisonton Indianapolis R.R. Co. by George Allen; thence North $28\frac{1}{2}$ M. Six Hundred and Eighty-Two feet; thence East to the present line; thence North $28\frac{1}{2}$ M. Six Hundred and Eighty-Two feet; thence East to the point last hereafter being; thence North $28\frac{1}{2}$ M. Six Hundred and Eighty-Two feet; thence running North One location of said Rail Road; thence with said road running North One specified; commencing again at the point first mentioned, thence running North $28\frac{1}{2}$ M. Six Hundred and Forty-Two feet; thence West to the alley first above mentioned.
