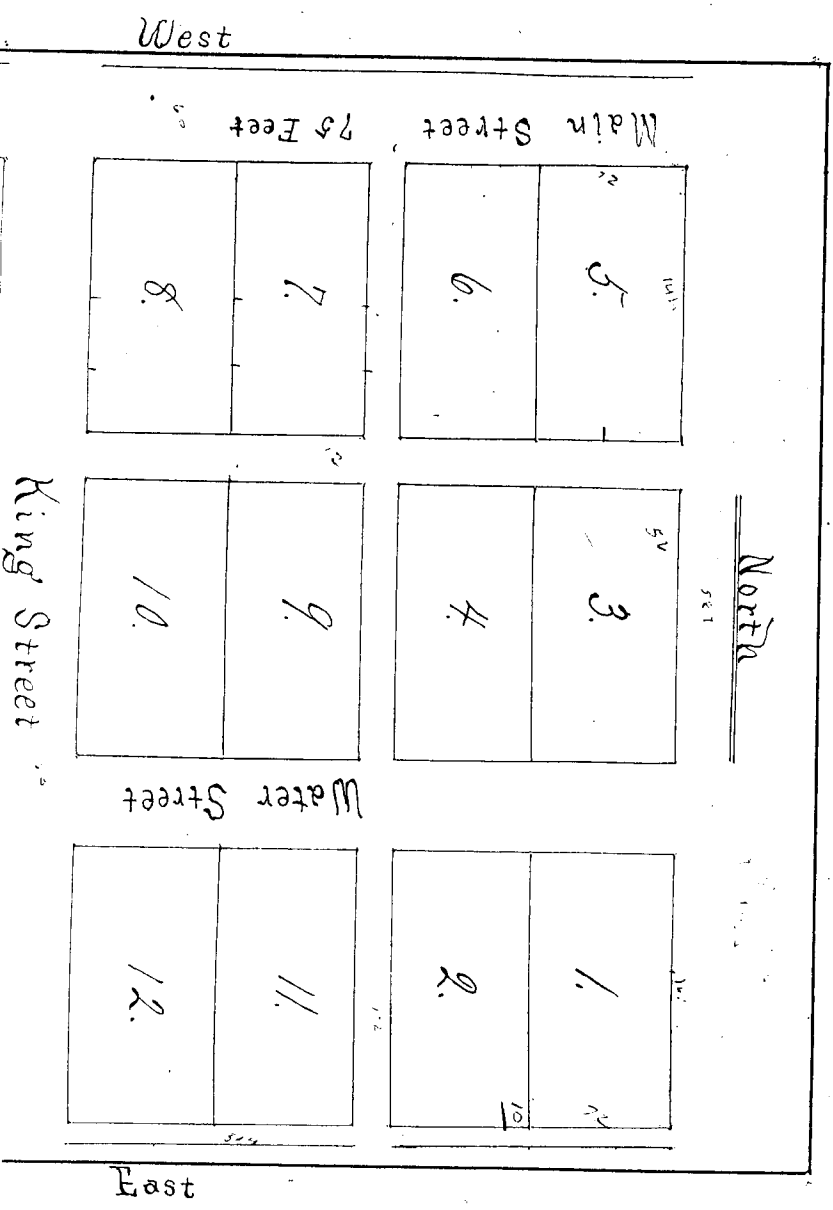
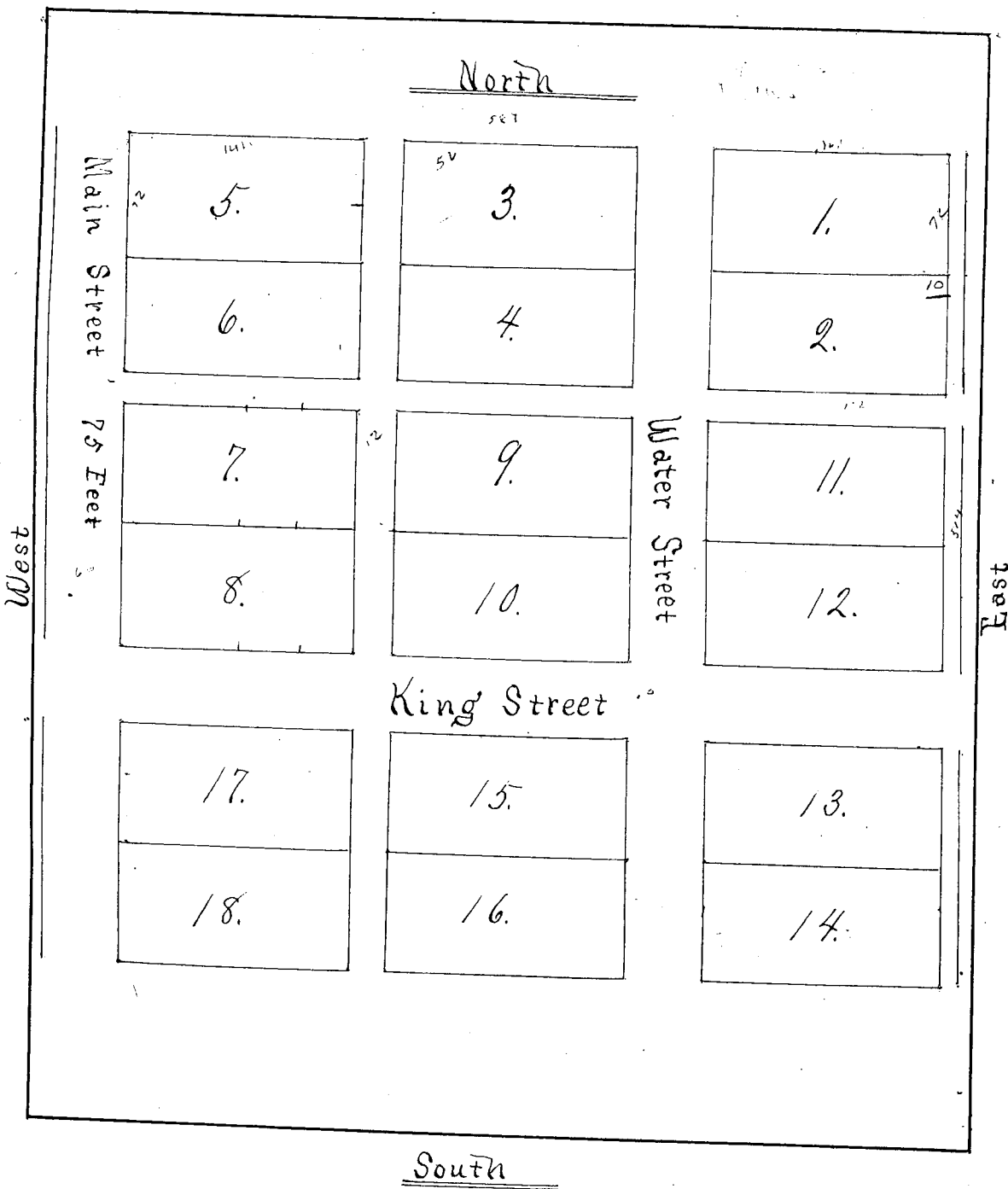

Three lots are laid down in the annexed Plat are bounded on the West by Alley east of Lots No. 47, 48, 49 & 50 in the Original plat of said town, on the South by the North side of Monroe street, on the North by the South side of Jefferson street, on the East by such line as will, explain of Mechanic street include the said eight lots of the same quantity in size as to the lots in said town and seventy-two feet by One hundred & forty-four also including alley between said lots. East of 81st (more) feet wide, West sixty feet wide.

It is shown by these Records, that I George King of the County of Johnson and State of Indiana have laid off to the town of Franklin aforesaid Addition No 2, to two or more described containing Eight and the street and alley hereby are made public property and I do relinquish all and individually to the same to the lots so marked. It do retain all right of disposition.
