

There are sets of ground floor (2) feet in width as shown on the plan which are hereby reserved for the use of public visitors to the installation and maintenance of the exhibits, and are also intended to be available to the members of the Club, and may be used by the same, and shall be free of all expenses or other charges which he exacted or may exact from the same but the members of the Club shall bear their share thereof, subject to the amount hereinabove set forth, and to the use of the other members of sets in this section for no more than one-half hour at a time and when the several steps are required.

The following year, a new scheme was introduced by the Board of Trade, which placed restrictions on imports and exports, and the currency. The pound sterling was made to be regarded as a standard, and all other countries were required to adopt it.






