

No animals, livestock or poultry of any description shall be raised, bred, or kept on any lot, except that dogs, calls or other household pets may be kept, provided that they are not kept, bred or maintained for commercial purposes.

It shall be the duty of the owner of each lot in this subdivision to keep the grass on the lot property cut and to keep the lot free from weeds and tresh and otherwise meat and attractive in appearance. Should any owner fall to do so then Developer may take such action as it deems appropriate in order to make the lot neat and attractive and the owner shall upon demand reimburse Developer for the expense incurred in so doing.

No lot in this subdivision shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubblish, trash, garbage, or other waste, and shall not be kept, except in sanitary containers.

It is further understood and agreed that pursuant to 12 36-9-22-1, that as part of the consideration running to the City of Noblesylle, the developer herein prevaculty releases its right and the right of its successors in title to remonstrate against pending or future annexation to the City of Noblesylle. The right to senforce the within restrictions, limitations and covenants by in junction is hereby dedicated and reserved to owners of locis in this subdivision, their heirs and assigns, who shall be entitled to such realir without being required to show any damage of any kind to any such owner or owners, by or through any such vidualition or attempted viduation. Such previsions shall be and continue in full force and effect for a period of Tenty (20) years from the date of this plat, and thereafter unless and until by a vote of the their owners of a two theirs majority of the total lots in this subdivision it is agreed to change the coverants in whole or in part. COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS FOR PINE KNOLL. SECTION 5

DAVID J. STREPPELIDEETH AND

Promonitary Goup Inc., of Marian County, in the State of Indiana, being the owners of record of all the above described tract of land, hereby lay off, plat and subdivide into late and streets such tracts and do hereby dedicate for public use any of such streets not previously dedicated, in accordance with the within plat. The following restrictions, limitations and covenants are hereby imposed and shall run with the land contained in such plat.

The within plot shall be known and designated as Pine Knoil, Section 5 a subdivision in Hamilton County, State of Indiana.

All lots in this subdivision are reserved for residential use, and no building other than a one-family residence or structure or facility accessory in use thereta shall be erected thereon.

Not more than one building shall be erected or used for residential purposes on any lot in this subdivision.

The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one—story open porches and garages, shall be not less that Twelve hundred (1200) square feet in the case of a one-story structure, nor less than seven hundred fifty (750) square feet in the case of a multiple story structure, provided no structure of more than one story shall have less than an aggregate of Fifteen hundred (1500) square feet of finished and liveable floor area. All garages shall be attached to the residence dwelling and be a minimum of two car size.

No trailer, tent, shock, attached shed, besement only, garage or temporary building shell be used for temporary or permanent residence on any lot in this subdivision. An attached garage, tool shed or detached storage building eracted or used as an accessory to a residence in this subdivision shall be of a permanent type of construction and conform to the general architecture and appearance of such residence.

No fences shall be erected in this subdivision between the building lines and the property lines of the streets as shown on the within plot, except with approval of the Architectural Control Committee, which fences shall not exceed 42 inches in height and shall be of a decorative nature.

No building, structure or occessory building shall be erected closer to any side lot line than 9 feet with a combined aggregate of 18 feet.

No structure in this subdivision shall exceed 2 1/2 stories or 25 feet in height measured from finish grade to the underside of eave line, and no structure other than an open perch shall be erected between the building line as designated on the plot and the property line of the street. No building shall be exected, placed or altered on any building plot in this subdivision until the building plans, specifications and plot plan showing the location of such building has been approved as to the conformity and harmony of external design with existing structures herein and as to the building with respect to topography and finished ground elevation, by the Architectural Control Committee compased of the undersigned owners of the herein described real estate, or by their duly authorized representatives. In the event of the death or resignation of any member of sold committee, the remaining member or members shall have full authority to approve or disapprove such design and location, or to designate a representative with like authority. If the committee fails to act upon any plans submitted to it for its approval within a period of fifteen (15) days from the submission date of the some, the owner may proceed them with the building according to the plans as approved. Neither the committee members nor the designated coverant.

The utility ecomments shown on the within plat are reserved as ecomments for use of city or county in which the subdivision is located, owners in this subdivision, and public utility companies for the installation, use, maintenance, repair and removal of sewers, water mains, utility poles, wires and other facilities and utilities necessary or incidental to the common welfers and use and occupancy for residential purposes of the houses to be erected in this subdivision. No building or other structure, except welks or driveways, shall be erected or maintained upon, over, under or across any such utility strip for any use except as set forth herein and owners in this subdivision shall take their title to the land contained in such utility strip subject to the perpetual sessment herein reserved.

No compers, trailers, boots or similar vehicles shall be parked on any lot in this subdivision unless the same shall be parked in such a manner that it is not visible to the occupants of other lots in this subdivision, the users of any street in this subdivision.

All lot owners shall be required to install, or have installed, at least one gas or electric "dusk to down" yard light in the front.

The drainage easements shown on the within plot are reserved for the drainage of storm water, whether by swale, ditch, or storm sever. No structure other than storm water drainage structures, retaining wale, or elevated walks and driveways shall be erected in, on, over, under or across any such easement except that a drainage easement may also be used as a utility strip, and structures permitted in a utility may be erected therein provided that they do not interfere with the flow of water. Owners in this subdivision shall take their title to the land contained in such drainage easement subject to the perpetual easement herein reserved.

Ecsement Maintenance: On drainage easements, the City of Noblesville shall be responsible for the care, maintenance, repair and/or replacement of actual structures in place such as sever pipes, manholes, castings, etc., and each property owner as it pertains to his lot or lots shall maintain surface drainage systems and open seules. The City shall have access rights over and across said easements. In the event storm water drainage from any lot or lots flows across another lot, provision shall be made to permit such drainage from any lot or lots flows across another lot, provision shall be made to permit such drainage to continue without restriction or reduction, across the downstream lot and into the natural drainage channel or course, even though no specific drainage easement for such flow of water is provided on said plot.

In order to provide for the continued maintenance of certain drainage structures located within the subdivision, there is hereby created the "Pine Knoll Common Property Maintenance Committee". The Committee shall be composed of the undersigned owners of the herein described real estate or by their duly authorized representatives for so long as the undersigned owners retain title to one or more lots within the subdivision. Thereafter, the Committee shall be composed of three (3) persons who are each owners of One (1) or more lots within the subdivision to be elected annually be a majority vate of all of the record owners of lots within the subdivision. Such election shall take place between January 1st and January 15th of each calendar year with the Committee members taking office on February let of each year. The Pine Knoll Common Property Maintenance Committee shall make an annual assessment against each lot within the subdivision, the amount of the assessment to be determined by the Committee, for the purpose of creating a fund which may be utilized to finance the repair, replacement and maintenance of any of the common properties or facilities within the subdivision. The undersigned owners hereby retain for the Committee the right to impose a lien against any lot to secure the payment of any and all assessments made. The fund created by this provision shall be safely dedicated to the maintenance, repair or replacement of common properties or improvements within the subdivision and shall be utilized for no other purpose.
