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DECLARATION OF COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS
OF PONDS WEST

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Declaration (harainsfeer feferred to as 2 "that Declaration" or "this Declaration", made as of Part Pay of MAY, 1973, by Dart Development Corp. II an indiana on particular of the section (hereinsfeer referred to as the "lectarant").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Developer is the owner of the parcels of real estate located in Hamilton County, Indiana, which are more particularly described in <u>Exhibit A</u>, attached hereto and hereby incomposated berein by reference (hereineiter referred to. collectively, as the 'Original Tract'); and

WHEREAS, Declarant has the right and the option to acquire the percel of real estate in Hamilton County. Indiana scient is more particularly described in Exhibit "B" and and hereby incorporated herein by reference (hereinafter referred to as the "Additional Tract"); and

Whereas, Declarant reserve the right, but not the obligation. from time to time, to acquire Additional Tract or tracts of land contiguous or proximal to the Original and/or he Additional Tract prior to the applicable date, whereupon such after acquired tract(s) shall be made subject to the terms of this Reclaration as hereinafter provided;

MHEREAS, Declarant intends to create on the Original Tract (and may in the future desire to create on such portions (or all) of the Additional Tract as may be made subject to the terms of this Declaration, as hereinafter provided) a residential community with public streets, private open spaces and landscaped areas, including likes and jends and which community may include certain recreational facilities and amenities, for the benefit of such residential community, to be known as, "losses WEST"; and

enhancement of the values and amenities in such community and the common areas therein contained, and, to talk end, Declarant desires to subject the Original Tract (together with such portions (or all)

of the Additional Tract as may hereafter be made subject to the terms of this Declaration, as hereinafter provided) to certain rights, privileges, covenants, restrictions, easements, charges, essessments, liens, each and all to the extent herein provided, for he benefit of the Original Tract [together with such portions (or all) of the Additional Tract as may hereafter be made subject to the terms of this Declaration as hereinafter provided] and each owner of all or part thereof; and

WERRAS, Declarent deems it desireable, for the efficient preservation of the values and esecuties in said community, to create an egency to which shall be delegated and assigned the powers of owning, saintaining and administering any common areas located on the Real Estate (hereinafter defined), administering and estaurities the towerents and restrictions tourished in this Declaration, outletting and discoursing the descentesmits and only as imposed and created hereby and hereunder and prosecting the health, safety and welfare of the owners of the Real estate, and parts thereof; and

incorporated under the laws of the State of Indiana a not-forprofit corporation under the name "Ponds West Homeowners Association, Inc.", or similar name, as such agency for the purpose of exercising such functions;

is and shall be held, transferred, sold, conveyed, hypothecated, encumbered, leased, rented, used, improved and occupied subject to the provisions, agreements, conditions, covenants, restrictions, essessments, charges and liens hereinafter set forth, all of which are declared to be ... furtherance of a plan for preservation and enhancement of the Real Listate, and are established and agreed upon for the purpose of enhancing and protecting the value, desirability and attractiveness of the Real Estate as a whole and of each the lots situated therein.

Article I

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Section 1. The following words and terms, when used herein or the arguments of amendment because, understand the contrast results requires otherwise, shall have the following meanings:

(a) "Act" shall mean and refer to the Indiana Not-for-profit Comparation Act of 1971 as assembed:

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- (3) "Applicable Date" shall mean and refer to the date determined pursuant to Article IV, Section 2 (b) of this Declaration:
- (C) "Approvals" shall mean and refer to approvals, determinations, permissions, or consents required hersin and shall be deemed given if they are given in writing eigned with respect to the Declarant or the Corporation by the President or Vice-President thereof, and with respect to the Committee, by two meaders increas.
- (d) "Articles" shall mean and refer to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, as the same may be amended from time to time;
- (e) "Board" or "board of Directors" shall mean and refer to the governing body of the Corporation elected, selected or appointed as provided for in the Articles, By-Laws and this Declaration;
- (f) "By-Laws" shall mean and refer to the Code of By-Laws of the Corporation, as the same may amended from time to time:
- (g) "Committee" shall mean and refer to the "Ponds West Building Control Committee", the same being the committee or entity established pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1 of this Declaration for the purposes herein stated:
- (h) "Common Areas" shall mean and refer to (1) all portions of the Real Estate shown on any recorded subdivision plat of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, which are not dedicated to the public and which are not identified as lots on any such plat (such as public streets), whether such plat is heretofore or hereafter recorded, (ii) to the extent hereinafter established such portions of the Real Estate as are herein declared to be Common Areas even though located on or constituting part of one or scre such lots shown on any such plat, and (iii) to the extent hereinafter established, such improvements located, installed or established in, to, under, across or through the Real Estate as are herein declared to be Common Areas whether located, installed or established entirely or partially on lots (as herein defined) or portions of the Real Estate which are not lots, or both;
- (1) "Common Expenses" shall mean and refer to expenses of administration of the Corporation, and expenses for the upweep, maintenance, repair and replacement of the Common Areas, and all sums, costs and expenses declared by this Declaration to be Common Expenses;
- (1) "Compensation" shall mean and refer to Ponds West Homeowners Association, Inc., an Indiana not-for-profit componation which Declarant has caused, or will cause, to be incompensated under said name or similar name, its successors and assigns;
- (K) "Declarant" shall mean and refer to Dart Development Corp. II. an Indiana corporation, and any successors and

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samigns of it whom it designates in one or more written recorded instruments to have the rights of Seciarant hereember, including but not insited to any mortgages ecquiring title to any portion of the Seal Satate pursuent to the exercise of rights under, or fureclosure of, a mortgage executed by Declarant;

- (1) "Drainage System" shell mean and refer to the open drainage ditches, the subsurface drainage tiles, pipes and structures, the dry and wet retention and/or detention areas, and the other structures, fixtures, properties, equipment and facilities located on the Real Batate and designed for the purpose of controlling, retaining or expediting the drainage of surface and subsurface waters trom, over and surcess the Davelopment, including but not limited to those shown or referred to on a Plat, all or part of which may be established as legal drains subject to the jurisdiction of the Hamilton County brainage Soard, its successors or assigns;
- (m) "Dwelling Units" shall mean and refer to any building, atructure or portion thereof situated an the Real Estata designed and intended for use and occupancy as a residence by one (1) single family;
- (n) "Lot" shall mean and refer to any and each portion of the Real Setate (excluding any part of the Common Areas) designed and intended for use as a building site for, or developed and improved for use as, a Dwelling Unic (which shall be deemed to include any other buildings or improvements appurtenant to such Dwelling Unit), as dusignated by Declarant by its deed of the same to another Person. A Lot will not necessarily be the same as any individually numbered percel of land shown upon, and identified as a lot on, any recorded subdivision plat of the Real Satate or any part thereof. For purposes of this Declaration, a "Lot" may be (1) any individually numbered parcel of land identified as a lot on such subdivision plat, (ii) part of such a numbered parcel of land, (iii) such a numbered parcel of land combined with part or all of another such numbered parcel of land, or (iv) parts or all of two (2) or more of such numbered parcels of land combined. The determination of what portion of the Real Estate constitutes a "Lot" for purposes of this Declaration shall be made by reference to, and shall mean, each tract of land conveyed by Deciarant to another Person for use as a building site for, or developed and improved for use as, a Dwelling Unit (which shall be deemed to include any other buildings or improvements appurtenant to such Dwelling Unit). Notwithstanding the foregoing, if after the initial conveyance of a portion of the Real Estate by Declarant to another Person it is agreed between the Declarant and such Person to enlarge or reduce or otherwise change the portion of the Real Estate so critically conveyed to such Person as a "lot", then the determination of what portion of the Real Estate constitutes such a "lot" for purposes of this Declaration shall be made by reference to, and shall mean, such "Lot" initially so conveyed by Declarant, as the same has been adjusted or changed at any time by conveyances by and between Declarant and such Parson. Any deed or other instrument of conveyance so adjusting or changing the description of a "Lot" shall state on its face that it is made for such purposes. Any part of a "Lot" reconveyed to Declarant shall, upon such re-conveyance, lose its character as part of a "Lot" and thereafter by conveyed by Declarant as part of another "Lot". The foregoing procedures may be used to correct errors in descriptions, to adjust boundary lines of "Lots" or for any other reason;

- (b) "Mortpapes" shall meen and rafer to the holder of a recorded first mortgage lies on a Lot or Dwelling Unit:
- (p) "Owner" shall mean and refer to (i) the Declarant, as to each Lot owned by it and as to each individually numbered percel of land shown upon, and identified as a lot an any recorded subdivision plat of the Real Estate (or any part thereof) of which it is the owner (either as to the entire numbered percel or any part thereof) which is not a lot, and (ii) the recorded owner, whether one or more Persons, of the fee simple title to any Lot, provided, however, that Owner shall not include or mean or refer to a mortgages or tenant unless and until such mortgages or tenant title to any Lot, but upon so acquiring title to any Lot a mortgages or tenant bas acquiring title to any Lot.
- (q) "Person" shall mean and refer to an individual, firm, corporation, partnership, association, trust, or other logal entity, or any combination thereof;
- (r) "Real Estate" shall mean and refer to the Original Tract, additional tract and after acquired tract as have, from time to time, been subjected to, and are, at any time subject to this declaration;
- (8) "Restrictions" shall mean and refer to the agreements, conditions, covenants, restrictions, easements, assessments, charges, liens and all other provisions set forth in this Declaration, as the same may be amended from time to time; and
- (t) "Site Plan" shall mean and refer to the preliminary plan reflecting Daclarant's proposed development of the Original Tract and the Additional Tract (if the entire Additional Tract is subjected to this Declaration), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Other terms and words defined elsewhere in this Declaration shall have the meanings herein attributed to them.

REAL ESTATE SUSJECT TO THIS DECLARATION: DECLARANT'S RIGHT TO SUBJECT ADDITIONAL TRACT TO THIS DECLARATION

Section 1. Declaration. Declarant hereby expressly declares that the Real Estate shall be held, transferred, sold, conveyed and occupied subject to all the Restrictions. As of the date of execution of this Declaration, the Seal Estate consists solely of the Original Tract. The Owner of any Lot at any time shall be subject to the Restrictions and this Declaration, (i) by acceptance of a deed conveying title thereto, or the execution of a contract for the purchase thereof, whether from Declarant or a subsequent Owner of such Lot, or (ii) by the act of occupancy of

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any Lot, shall conclusively be deemed to have accepted such deed, executed such contract and undertaken such occupancy subject to all Restrictions contained in this Declaration. By acceptance of such deed, execution of such contract or undertaking such occupancy, each Owner and all other Persons acknowledge the rights and powers of Declarant, the Committee and the Corporation with respect to or under this Declaration, and, for himself, his hairs, personal representatives, successors and assigns, covenant, agree and consent to and with Declarant, the Committee and the Corporation, and the Owners and subsequent Owners of each of the Lots affected by this Declaration, to keep, observe, perform and comply with the terms and provisions of this Declaration.

Section 2 Declarant's Right of Expansion. Declarant shall have, and hereby expressly reserves, the right, but not the obligation, at any time and from time to time, on or before the applicable date to add to the real estate and subject to this Declaration all or any part of the Additional Tract or after acquired tract. Any portion of the Additional Tract or after acquired tract shall be added to the Real Estate, and therefore and thereby becomes a part of the Real Estate and subject in all and appearance and appears a design and a second and a second and a second and and a second and Hamilton County, Indiana an instrument so declaring the same to be a part of the Real Estate which beclaration may be made a part of the subdivision plat of any portion of the Additional Tract or after sequired tract, or by an amendment or supplement to this Declaration, or by the deed conveying any portion of the Additional Tract to a Person other than Declarant, or otherwise. Upon the recording of any such instrument on or before the Applicable Date. the real estate described therein shall, for all purposes thereafter be deemed a part of the Real Estate and the laners of any lots within such real estate shall be deemed for all purposes to have and be subject to all the rights, duties, privileges and obligations of Owners of Lots within the Real Estate. No single exercise of Declarant's right and option to add to and expand the host Estate, as described in this Section 2, as to any part or

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parts of the Additional Tract or after acquired tract shall preclude Declarant from thereafter from time to time further expanding and adding to the Real Estate, to include other portions of the Additional Tract, and such right and option of expansion may be exercised by Declarant from time to time as to all or any position of the Additional Tract or after acquired tract so long as such expansion is accomplished on or before the Applicable Date. Such expansion of the Real Estate is entirely at the discretion of Declarant and nothing contained in this Declaration or otherwise shall require Declarant to expand the Real Estate beyond the Original Tract, or any other portions of the Additional Tract or after acquired tract which Declarant may voluntarily and in its sole discretion from time to time subject to this Declaration.

ARTICLE III Common Areas: Chligations of Declarant as to Common Areas Declarant's Reserved Rights as to Recreational Facilities

Section 1. The Common Areas. The Common Areas shall consist of the portions of the Real Estate, and improvements thereon or thereto, as defined in Article I. Section 1(g) of this Declaration. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Common Areas shall include the following portions of the Original Tract and the Additional Tract, and improvements thereon or thereto, to the extent the same have been subjected to this Declaration and are part of the Real Estate:

- (a) The four (4) entrance storm water detention pends or lakes shown on the Site Plan, including all land areas surrounding the same which are shown upon the Site Plan as, and may be shown on subdivision plats of the Real
- Astate as "Common Areas" or "Lake Maintenance Easement",

 (b) Landscaping to be installed in any islands, esplanades, cul-de-sac or cul-de-loop areas within the right-of-way of any streets within the Real Estate, or elsewhere within the real estate, including entry way walls, fences or other structures, subdivision identification signs, street signs or directories. landscape irrigation systems, decent lighting systems and other similar items to be installed in "Landscaping Easements" noted or to be noted on subdivision plats of the Real Estate, or at or in proximity to the street entrances to the Real Estate from Springmill Road and 146th Street; and
- (c) The following improvements (hereinafter referred to, collectively, as the "Recreational Facilities") to be installed in the "Common Area" located between lots as shown in the Site Pages.

(1) One (1) or more termis courts.

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- (11) A swimming pool and bathhouse, and
- (iii) An off-street vehicle parking area.

Section 2. Addressent to Construct and Convey Common Areas.

Declarant will, prior to the Applicable Date, construct or provide for the Common Areas described herein to the extent the same are due to be located on portions of the Original Tract or the Additional Tract which are subjected to this Declaration and are part of the Real Estate. Upon final construction or provision of such Common Areas, Declarant covenants to convey all of its right, title and interest in end to said Common Areas to the Comporation and all such right, title and interest in and to said items (whether owned in fee, by leasehold, by contract or in the nature of an essential or license) shall then be the property of the Comporation, whether or not the same may be located entirely or partially on any one or more of the lots. The corporation convenients to accept such common area subject to the terms and conditions of this Declaration.

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Corporation: Membership: Voting: Functions

Section 1. Membership in Corporation. Declarant and each Owner of a Lot shall, automatically upon becoming an Owner, be and become a member of the Corporation and shall remain a member until such time as his ownership of a Lot ceases, but membership shall terminate when such Owner ceases to be an Owner, and will be transferred to the new Owner of his Lot; provided, however, that any Person who holds the interest of an Owner in a Lot merely as security for the performance of an obligation shall not be a member until and unless he forecloses upon his security, at which time he shall automatically be and become an Owner and a member of the Corporation

Section 2. Voting Rights. The Corporation small have the following classes of membership, with the following voting rights:

(a) Class A. Class A members shall all be Owners except Class B members. Each Class A member shall be entitled to one (1) vote for each Lot of which such member is the

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Owner with respect to each mattal submitted to a vote of members upon which the Class A members are entitled to vote. When more them (1) Person constitutes the Owner of a particular Lot, all such Persons shall be members of the Corporation, but all of such Persons shall have only (1) vote for such Lot, which vote shall be exercised as they among themselves determine, but in no event shall more than one (1) vote be cast with respect to any such Lot.

- Class B. Class & members shall be Declarant and all successors and sessions of Declarant designated by (b) Class B. Declarant as Class & assours in a written notice salled or delivered to the resident agent of the Corporation. Each Class B member shall be entitled to five (5) votes for each Lot of which it is the Gener and five (5) votes for each individually numbered percel of land shown upon and identified as a lot on, any recorded subdivision plat of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, of which it is the Owner (either as to the entire numbered parcel or any part thereof) which is not a "lot" as defined in this Declaration, on all matters requiring a vote of the members of the Corporation. The Class B membership shall cease and terminate upon the first to occur of (i) the date upon which the written resignation of the Class B members as such is delivered to the resident agent of the Corporation, (ii) the date Declarant no longer owne any Lots nor any portion of any individually numbered parcel of land shown upon, and identified as a lot or, any recorded subdivision plat of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, or (iii) December 31, 2000 (the Applicable Data"). After the Applicable Date, Class B memberships shall be converted to Class A memberships, and each former Class B member shall be entitled to one (1) Class A membership for each Lot owner and for each individually numbered parcel of land shown upon, and identified as a lot on, any recorded subdivision plat of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, of which it is then the owner (either as to the entire numbered name) as to the entire numbered parcel or any part thereof) which is not a "Lot" as defined herein.
- (c) <u>Special</u>. Until the Applicable Date, there shall be three (3) additional Special members of the Corporation, being the persons from time to time appointed by Declarant to serie on the "Initial Board" pursuant to Section 2 of Article V hereof. Persons who are special members shall not be deemed or considered members of the Corporation non Comers of Lots for any purpose other than to qualify to act as members of the Initial Board. Special members shall have no voting rights on any matters submitted to a vote of the members fundeds such Special member is also a Class A member, in which event his voting rights shall be governed by subsection (a) of this Section 2).

Section 3. Punctions. The Corporation has been (or will be) formed for the purpose of providing for the maintenance, repair, replacement, administration, operation and ownership of the Common Areas as and to the extent provided herein, to pay taxes assessed against and payable with respect to the Common Areas, to pay any other necessary expenses and costs in connection with the Common Areas and to perform such other functions as may be designated for to perform under this Declaration or under any recorded

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subdivision plat of the Real Esuate, whether heretofore or hereafter recorded.

ARTICLE Y

Section 1. Hanagement. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be governed 'nd managed by the Soard of Elizations. No person shall be eligible to serve as a manner of the Board of Directors unless he is, or is dessed in accordance with this Declaration to be, an Osmar, including a person appointed by Declarant as provided in Section 2 of this Article V.

Section 2. Initial Board of Directors, The initial Board of Directors shall be composed of the persons designated or to be designated in the Articles, to-writ: Devid J. Freiburger, John J. Rennelly and Thomas L. Mitchell (herein referred to as the "Initial Board"), all of whom have been or shall be appointed by Declarant. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in, or any other provisions of, this Declaration, the Articles, the By-Laws or the Act (a) the Initial Board shall bold office until the first meeting of the members of the Corporation occurring on or after the Applicable Date, and (b) in the event of any vacancy or vacancies occurring in the Initial Board for any reason or cause whatsoever prior to such first meeting occurring on or after the Applicable Data determined as provided above, every such vacancy shall be filled by a person appointed by Declarant, who shall thereafter be d amed a member of the Initial Board. Each Owner, by acceptance of a deed to a Lot, or by acquisition of any interest in a Dwelling Unit by any type of juridic acts inter vivos or causa mortis, or otherwise, shall be deemed to have appointed Declarant as such Owner's agent, attorney-in-fact and proxy, which shall be deemed coupled with an interest and irrevocable until the Applicable Data determined as provided above, to exercise all of said Owner's right to vote, and to vote as Declarant determines, on all matters as to which members of the Corporation are entitled to vote under the Declaration, the Articles, the By-Laws, the Act or otherwise. This appointment of Declarant as such Owner's agent, attorney-in- fact and proxy shall not be affected by incompetence of the Owner DECLARATION - PUNDS WEST 10

granting the same. Each Person serving on the Initial Board, whether as an original member thereof or as a member thereof appointed by Daclarant to fill a vacancy, shall be deemed a Special member of the Corporation and an Owner solely for the purpose of qualifying to act as a member of the Board of Directors and for no other purposes. No such Person serving on the Initial Board shall be deemed or considered a member of the Corporation nor an Owner of a lint for any purpose (unless he is actually the Corporation to the thereby a member of the Corporation).

Section 1. Additional Destrictions. More an Owner consists of more than one Person or is a partnership, corporation, trust or other legal entity, then one of the Persons constitution the multiple Owner, or a partner or an officer or trustee. If we will be serve on the Board of Directors Lot or Desiling Unit may be represented on the Board of Directors by more than one Person at a time.

Section 4. Term of Office and Vaccours. Sugar to the provisions of Section 2 of this Article V, the entire membership of the Board of Directors shall be elected at each annual meeting of the Corporation. The Initial Board shall be deemed to be elected and re-elected as the Board of Directors at each annual meeting until the first meeting of the members occurring on or after the Applicable Date provided herein. After the Applicable Date, each member of the Board of Directors shall be elected for a term of one (1) year. Each Director shall hold office throughout the term of his election and until his successor is elected and qualified. Subject to the provisions of Section 2 of this Article V as to the Initial Board, any vacancy or vacancies occurring in the Board shall be filled by a vote of a majority of the remaining members of the Board or by vote of the Owners if a Director is removed in accordance with Section 5 of this Article V. The Director so filling a vacancy shall serve until the next annual meeting of the members and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Section 5. Removal of Directors. A Director or Directors. except the members of the Initial Board, may be removed with or

cast at a special meeting of the Owners duly called and constituted for such purpose. In such case, his successor shall be elected at the same meeting from eligible Owners nominated at the meeting. A Director so elected shall serve until the next annual meeting of the Owners and until his successor is duly elected and qualified.

Section 6. Duties of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall be the governing body of the Corporation representing all of the Comers and being responsible for the functions and duties of the Corporation, including but not limited to, providing for the administration of the Real Estate, the management, maintenance, repair, upkeep and replacement of the Common Areas(unless the same are otherwise and responsibility or duty of Owners), and the collection and disbursement of the Common Expenses. After the Applicable Date, the Board may, on buhalf of the Corporation, exploy a reputable and recognized professional property management agent (herein called the "Managing Agent") upon such terms as the Board shall find, in its discretion, reasonable and customary. The Managing Agent, if one is employed, shall assist the Board in carrying out its duties, which include, but are not limited to:

- Areas, unless the same are otherwise the responsibility or duty of Owners of Lots; provided, however, that this duty shall not include or be deemed or interpreted as a requirement that the Corporation, the Board or any Managing Agent must provide any on-site or roving guards, security service or security system for protection or surveillance, and the same need not be furnished;
- (b) procuring of utilities used in connection with the Lots, Dwelling Units and Common Areas (to the extent the same are not provided and builed directly to Owners of Lots and Dwelling Units by utility companies) and snow removal from the Street; streets within the Real Estate (if the appropriate governmental authority exercising jurisdiction over such streets is unable or unwilling to provide such snow removal);
- (c) landscaping, painting, decorating, furnishing, and maintenance and upkeep of, the Common Areas:
- (d) assessment and collection from the Owners of the Owners' respective shares in the Common Expenses;
- (e) preparation of the proposed annual budget, a copy of which will be mailed or dilivered to each Owner at the same time as the notice or the chiudi or special meeting at which the same is to be detect upon is mailed or

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delivered:

- (f) preparing and delivering annually to the Owners a full accounting of all receipts and expenses incurred in the prior year: if possible, such accounting shell be delivered to each Owner simulteneously with delivery of the proposed annual budget for the current year;
- (g) kneping a current, accurate and datailed record of receipts and expanditures affecting the Common Areas and the business and affairs of the Corporation, specifying and itemizing the Common Expanses; all records and wouchers shall be available for exemination by an Owner at any time during normal business hours;
- (h) procuring and maintaining for the benefit of the Corporation, the Owners, any Managing Agent and the Board of insurance coverages required under this Declaration and such other insurance coverages as the Board, in its sole discretion, may deem necessary or advisable:
- (1) paying taxes and assessments levied and assessed against, and payable with respect to, the Common Areas and paying any other necessary expenses and costs in connection with the Common Areas; and
- (j) procuring weekly trash removal services for the benefit of the Owners for which services the Cwners may be billed directly; and
- (k) all duties and obligations imposed upon the Corporation or the Board under this Declaration, the Articles, the By-Laws, the Act, or any recorded subdivision plat of the Real Estate whether herutofore or hereafter recorded.

Section 7. Powers of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall have such powers as are reasonable and necessary to accomplish the performance of their duties. These powers include, but are not limited to, the power:

- (a) to employ a Managing Agent to assist the Board in performing its duties;
- (b) to purchase, lease or cherwise obtain for the Corporation, to enable it to periors its functions and duties, such equipment, materials, labor and services as may be necessary in the judgment of the Board of Directors;
- (c) to employ legal counsel, architects, contractors, accountants and others as in the judgment of the Board of Directors may be necessary or desirable in connection with the business and affairs of the Corporation;
- (4) to employ, designate discharge and remove such personnel as in the judgment of the Board of Directors may be necessary for the maintenance, upkeep, repair and replacement of the Common Areas and to perform all other maintenance, upkeep, repair and replacement duties of the Corporation and the Board;
- (e) to include the costs of performing all of its functions, duties and obligations as Commor Expenses and to pay all of such costs therefrom;

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- (f) to open and maintain a bank account or accounts in the name of the Corporation;
- (g) to promulgate, adopt, revise, amend and alter from time to time such additional rules and regulations with respect to use, occupency, operation and enjoyment of the Real Estate and the Common Areas (in addition to those set forth in this Declaration) as the Board, in its discretion, deems necessary or advisable; provided, however, that copies of any such additional rules and regulations so adopted by the Board shall be promptly delivered to all Owners; and
- (h) to grant to such public or private companies, entities or bodies as the Board shall approve, such easements as may be necessary to provide the Lots, Dealling Units and Common Areas with facilities for utility and similar services, including but not limited to cable television facilities and service; provided that such easements are limited within on any con-estmestive with any one or such seasements or Chemon. Acres Shren upon, and Discriminan as such on, or provided for in, any subdivision plat of the Real Estate, whether such plat is heretofore or hereafter recorded.

Section 8. Limitation on Board Action. After the Applicable Date, the authority of the Board of Directors to enter into contracts shall be limited to contracts involving a total expenditure of less than \$2,500.00 without obtaining the prior approval of a majority of the cumulative votes of the Cemers. except that in the following cases such approval shall not be necessary:

- (a) contracts for replacing or restoring portions of the Common Areas damaged or destroyed by fire or other casualty where the cost thereof is payable out of insurance proceeds actually received or for which the insurance carrier has acknowledged coverage;
- (b) proposed contracts and proposed expenditures expressly set forth in the proposed annual budget as approved by the Owners at the annual meeting; and
- (c) expenditures necessary to deal with emergency conditions in which the Board of Directors reasonably believes there is insufficient time to call a meeting of the Owners.

Section 9. Compensation. No Director shall receive any compensation for his services as such, except to such extent as may be expressly authorized by a majority vote of the Owners. The Managing Agent, if any is employed, shall be estitled to reasonable compensation for its services, the cost of which shall be a Common farence.

Section 10. Non-Liability of Directors and Officers. The Directors and officers of the Corporation shall not be liable to two ways not seen 14

the Owners or any other Persons for any error or alkieve of judgment exercised in carrying out their duties and responsibilities as directors and officers, except for their own individual willful misconduct, bad faith or gross negligence. The Corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless and defend each of the Directors and officers against any and all liability to any person, firm or corporation arising out of contracts made by the Board on behalf of the Corporation, unless any much contract shall have been made in bad faith. It is intended that the Directors and officers shall have no personal liability with respect to any contract made by them on behalf of the Corporation.

Section 11. Additional Indemnity of Directors and Officers. The Corporation shall indesmify, hold harmless and defend any Person, his bairs, assigns and legal representatives, made a party to any artion, suit or processing by reason of the fart that he is or was a Director or officer of the Corporation, equinat the reasonable expenses, including attorneys' fees, actually and necessarily incurred by him in connection with the defense of such action, suit or proceeding, or in connection with any appeal therein, except as otherwise specifically provided herein in relation to matters as to which it shall be adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding that such Director or officer is liable for gross negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duties. The Corporation shall also reimburse to any such Director or officer the reasonable costs of settlement of or judgment rendered in any action, suit or proceeding, if it shall be found by a majority vote of the Duners that such Director or officer was not guilty of gross negligence or misconduct. In making such findings and notwithstanding the adjustication in any action, suit or proceeding against a Director or officer, no Director or officer shall be considered or deemed to be guilty of or liable for deglipende or misconduct in the performance of his duties where acting in good faith, such Director or officer relied on the books and reduceds or the dorporation or atalements or advices made by or propared by the Managing Agent (if any) or any other officer or

employee thereof, or any eccountant, attorney or other person, tirm or corporation employed by the Corporation to render advice or service unless such Director or officer had actual knowledge of the falsity or incorrectness thereof; nor shall a Director or officer be deemed guilty of or liable for negligence or misconduct by virtue of the fact that he failed or neglected to attend a meeting or meetings of the Board of Directors.

Section 12. Bond. The Board of Directors may provide surety bonds and may require the Manag ng Agent (if any), the treasurer of the Corporation and any other officers as the Board deems necessary, to provide surety bonds, indemnifying the Corporation equinst largeny, theft, emperatement, forgery, misappropriation, wrongful abstraction, willful misapplication, and other acts of freud or dishonesty, in such sums and with such sureties as may be approved by the Board of Directors and any such bond shall specifically include protection for any insurance proceeds received for any reason by the Board. The expense of any such bonds shall be a Common Expense.

Section 13. Initial Management. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Declaration, Declarant shall have, and Declarant hereby reserves to itself, the exclusive right to manage or designate a Managing Agent for the Real Estate and Common Areas, and to perform all the functions of the Corporation, until the Applicable Date. Declarant may, at its option, engage the services of the Managing Agent affiliated with it to perform such functions and, in either case, Declarant or such Managing Agent shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for its services.

ARTICLE VI

Redi Estate Taxes: Utilities

Section 1. Real Estate Taxes. Real estate taxes on each Lot, and on any Dwelling Unit or other improvements on each Lot, are to be separately assessed and taxed to each Lot and shall be paid by the Owner of such Lot. Any real estate taxes or other assessments against the Common Areas shall be paid by the Corporation and the LAXVAN PROBREMS

... usted as a Common Expense.

Section 2. Utilities. Each Owner shall pay for his own actuations which, by the extent pussible shall be separately sequent to each lot and Dwalling Unit. Utilities which are not separately setted to an Owner's Lot or Dwalling Unit shall be treated as and paid as part of the Common Expense, unless otherwise determined by the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII

Maintenance, Riceirs and Replacements

Section 1. By Owners, Each Owner shall, at his own expense, be responsible for, and shall promptly perform as the need therefore arises, all saintenance, repairs, decoration and replacement of his own Dwelling Unit, both interior and exterior. In addition, each Owner shall furnish and be responsible for the maintenance of all portions of his Lot, except for such portions thereof as may, in accordance with the terms of this Declaration, be designated as a part of the Common Areas for purposes of maintenance only. All fixtures and equipment installed within or as part of a Dealling Unit. Commencing at the points where the utility lines, pipes, wires, conduits or systems enter the Lot upon which said Dwelling Unit is located, shall be maintained and kept in repair by the Owner thereof. Each Owner shall promptly perform all maintenance and repair of his Lot and Dwelling Unit which, if neglected, might adversely affect any other Lot or Dwelling Unit or any part of the Common Areas. Such maintenance and repairs include but are not limited to internal water lines, plumbing, electric lines, gas lines, appliances, and all other fixtures, equipment and somessories belonging to the Owner and a part of or appurtament to his Dwelling Unit or Lot.

Section 2. By the Corporation. Maintenance, repairs, replacements and upkeep of the Common Areas [including, but not limited to, the storm drainage system for the Real Estate (other than portions thereof established as legal drains subject to the jurisdiction of the Hamilton County Drainage Board and maintained 4: 10.1 shall cannot to the extent provided harmin as the

ARTICLE VIII

Pends West Building Control Committee Section 1.

Creation. There shall be, and hereby is, created and established the "Ponds West Building Control Committee" (the "Committee") to perform the functions provided to be performed by it hereunder or under any subdivision plat of the Real Estate. Until the Applicable Date, the Declarant, or not more than three (3) persons designated by it, shall constitute the Committee. After the Applicable Date, the Committee shall be a standard committee of the Corporation consisting of three (3) or more Persons as may, from time to time, we provided in the Symphome. If the Symphome ou not, at any time, provide for the Committee, then the Sourd shall be and constitute the Committee.

Section C. Character of the Feel Estate.

A. In Process. Every lot in the heal satate unless it is otherwise designated by the Declarant, is a residential lot and shall be used exclusively for single family residential purposes. At structure shall be erected, placed or permitted to remain upon

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any of said residential lots except a single family dwelling house and such other improvements, appurtunances and facilities as are usual and customery accessory uses to a single family dwelling house.

Prior to the commencement of any construction or demolition activity on a Lot, a delineation of the building area for each Lot shall be substitued to the Committee for approval by the Committee, and all trees outside the building, driving and parking areas shall be designated by type and size and shall not be removed unless approved by the Committee upon proof of unusual hardsnip in the practical utilization of the Lot and such removal shall not cause a material adverse effect upon the seathetic values of adjoining lands and rights-of-way. Trees inside the building area shall not be destroyed, but shall be sowed to other areas of the Lot, unless they exceed 12" in diameter and campor be nowed.

Unparaitted removal or destruction of trees by an Owner or his successors in title, other than by acts of God or circumstances beyond the Owner's control, shall, within sinety (90) days after notice in writing from the Committee, be replaced by a tree of a type and size established by the Committee, and upon failure to do so, the Committee shall cause such tree to be replaced and the cost of such replacement shall be a lien upon the Lot collectable in any court of law or equity together with reasonable attorney's fees for the enforcement of such lien. For purposes of executing this covenant, an easement for ingress and egress shall by and hereby is reserved on each Lot for the performance thereof.

Adequate physical barriers, such as straw bales or snow fence, shall be provided by builders to protect trees to be preserved from damage by construction equipment or otherwise in the erection of building improvements. Pruning of trees outside the building line shall be permitted subject to the review and approved of the Committee and shall be undertaken only by qualified persons having absquate equipment to properly protect and preserve such trees.

In addition to individual site plan restrictions and tree preservation administered by the Committee, platted building lines,

and minimum front, side and rear building lines anall be satestablished on any subdivision plats of the Real Estate or portions thereof. All construction upon the Real Estate shall be done in compliance with the requirements of all applicable zoning, building and other governmental laws, ordinances, codes and other regulations.

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- B. Residential Use of Accessory Structures Prohibited. No accessory uses or improvements shall be erected on any of the Lots prior to the erection thereon of a single family Deelling Unit. and to severe shall any such accessory us any temporary accounting which say be constructed upon a lot sunject to these Asstructures ever be used as a residence or deelling house or place for human occupancy or habitation.
- C. Occupancy and Residential Use of Partially Completed

 Dwelling House Prohibited. No Dwelling Unit constructed on any
 of the Lots shall be occupied or used for residential purposes or
 human habitation until it shall have been substantially completed.
 The determination of whether the Dwelling Unit shall have been
 substantially completed shall be made by the Committee and such
 decision shall be binding on all parties.

Section 3. Restrictions and Obligations Concerning Size. Placement and Maintenance of Dwelling Units and Other Structures.

- A. <u>Minimum Living Space Areas.</u> The minimum square footage of living space of Dwelling Units constructed on the Lots small be as specified in any recorded subdivision plats of the Real Estate.
- B. <u>Set-Back Requirements</u> Set-back and yard size requirements for Lots shall be as set forth on any necorded subdivision plats of the Real Estate.
- C. Mailboxes. In order to aid in the preservation of aesthetic appearances within the Real Estate, any mailbox installed on the Real Estate much be approved by the Committee as to size, location, height and composition before it is installed. A standard mailbox design will be prepared by the Committee, and such design shall be the standard for all mailboxes installed on the Real

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- D. Exterior Construction. The finished exterior of every building Unit and other building constructed or placed on any Lot shall be of material other than aluminum siding, vinyl siding, rollbrick siding or any other similar artificial material. All materials used on the exterior of any Dwelling Unit and any other building improvements on a Lot shall be subject to the approval of the Committee. All driveways must be paved from their point of commencation with the abunting street or result to their point of connection with the garage agreen.
- E. Heating Plants and Garages. Every Dwelling Unit located on the Real Estate must contain a heating plant installed in compliance with the required codes and capable of providing adequate heat for year-around human habitation of the Dwelling Unit. Every Dwelling Unit located on the Real Estate must have at least a two-car attached garage, and the same architectural design and materials as the Dwelling Unit.
- F. Diligence in Construction. Unless a delay is caused by strikes, war, court injunction or acts of God, every building whose construction or placement on any Let is begun shall be completed within nine (9) months after the beginning of such construction or placement. No improvement which has partially or totally been destroyed by fire or otherwise shall be allowed to remain in such state for more than two (2) months from the time of such destruction or damage.
- G. <u>Prohibition of Used Structures</u>. All structures constructed or placed on any for shall be constructed with substantially all new materials, and no used structures shall be relocated or placed on any such Lot.
- H. Maintenance of Lots and Improvements. The carer of any Lot shall at all times maintain the Lot and any improvements situated thereon in such a manner as to prevent the Lot or improvements from becoming unsightly and, specifically, such (where shall:
 - (1) Mow the Lot at such times as may be reasonably required in order to prevent the unsightly growth of vegetation

and noxious weeds and, in any event, not less frequently than once each month during the months of April through October, inclusive, of each year;

- (ii) Remove all debris or rubbish;
- (iii) Prevent the existence of any other condition that reasonably tends to detract from or diminish; the seathetic appearance of the Real Estate;
 - (iv) Cut down and resove dead trace;
 - (W) Where applicable, prevent debris and foreign material from entering drainage areas;
- (Vi) Keep the exterior or all improvements in such a state of repeir or maintenance as to avoid their becoming unsightly; and
- I. Faires. Kalls. and Structures. In order to aid in the preservation of the aesthetic appearance within the real estate and to help maintain an open view of the natural surroundings, the following restrictions and limitations will apply to rear yard or side yard fences, walls or screening structures:
- (i) No rear yard or side yard fence, wail or screening structure may exceed 48° in height on any Lot. An exception will be made if required by statute or ordinance in conjunction with a specified use of the property.
- (ii) The material and style used for rear yard or side yard fences or screening structures on Lots abutting or adjoining the common area surrounding the four entrance ponds [including Lot numbered 100] and Lots numbered 6, 7, 24, 25, 63, 64, 70, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, and 99 in sections 1 thru 4 as platted in Ponds West subdivision shall be limited to ornamental iron (black color) or orpamental eluminum (black odier). The material and style used for rear yard or side yard fences or screening structures on all other La s, shall be limited to: vinyl coated chain link (green, brown or black color) including rails and posts, split rail, ornamental iron or aluminum (black color), "Cape Cod" or vertical spaced wood picket, vertical wood shadow box, and vertical wood picket. Hidden electronic fencing will be allowed on any Lot. Stockade, ox-bow. basket weave, horizontal wood, galvanized chain link, wire, solid aluminum, or PVC tendes or screening structures will not be allowed on any Lot and portable or modular kennel or kennel systems will

not be allowed on any Lot.

install a fence parallel to these streets if a fence is installed by Declarant along any of these streets or parallel to a fence installed by Declarant along these streets. The Owner of the Lots may connect a side yard fence to a fence installed by Declarant along these streets.

Declarant's and the Corporation's Right to Perform ESKESIO Maintenance. In the event that any Owner of a Lot shall fail to maintain his Lot and any improvements situated thereon in accordance with the provisions of these Restrictions and the provisions of any recorded subdivision plats of the Real Estate. the Declarant, until the Applicable Date, and, thereafter, the Corporation, shall have the right, but not the obligation, by and through its agents and employees or contractors, to enter upon said Lot and repair, sow, clean or perform such other acts as may be reasonably necessary to make such Lot and improvements situated thereon, if any, conform to the requirements of these Restrictions and the provisions contained in any such subdivision plats. The cost thereof to the Declarant or the Corporation shall be collected as a special assessment against such Owner and his Lct in the manner provided for herein for the collection of Common Expenses. Neither the Declarant nor the Corporation, nor any of its agents, employees, or contractors, shall be liable for any damage which may result from any maintenance work performed hereunder.

Section 4. Provisions Respecting Disposal of Sanitary Waste.

- A. <u>Nuisances</u>. No outside toilets shall be permitted on any Lot except during a period of construction and then only with the consent of the Committee), and no similarly waste or other wastes shall be permitted to be exposed.
- B. <u>Construction of Sanitary Sewate Lines and Discosal</u>
 <u>Facilities</u>. All senitary sewage lines and disposal facilities on
 the Lots shall be designed, constructed, installed and maintained
 in accordance with the provisions and requirements of Hamilton

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.unity, Indiana, any other governmental or quasi-governmental elumines having jurisdiction over public sanitary sewers and these electricions.

- Secretion 5. Seneral Prohibitions. In addition to any subtrictions or limitations contained elsewhere in this Declaration or in any recorded subdivision plats of the Real Estate, the collowing limitations, restrictions and prohibitions shall govern the development, use and occupancy of the Real Estate:
- A. In General, No noxious or offensive activities shall be urried on any Lot, nor shall anything be done on any of said Lots hat shall become or be an unreasonable annoyance or nuisance to may Owner of another Lot.
- 5. Sillis. Surept as otherwise permitted by any suc.vision plats of the Real Estate or the Committee, no signs or
 .vivertisements shall be displayed or placed on any lot or
 .conscrures without the prior written approval of the Committee.
- C. Animals. No animals shall be kept or maintained on any of except usual household pets, and, in such cases, such household pets and in such cases, such household pets shall be kept reasonably confined so as not to become a missance.
- D. <u>Vehicle Parking.</u> No trucks, campers, trailers, secretational vehicles, boats, boat trailers or similar vehicles shall be parked on any street or Lot, unless the same are parked in a paraga.
- 5. Gerbade. Trush and Other Radiuse. No Gener of a Lot chail out or parmit the burning out-of-doors of garbage or other refuse, or shall any such Owner accumulate or permit the accumulation out-of-doors of such refuse on his Lot except as may be permitted as supparagraph F below. All houses shall be equipped with a characteristic.
- Full Storage Tanks and Trash Receptacles. Every tank for and storage of fuel that is installed outside any building shall be writed below the surface of the ground. Every outdoor receptacle ashas, trash, rubbish or garbage shall be installed underground ashall be so placed and kept as not to be

visible from any street within the Real Estate at any time, except at the time when refuse collections are being made.

- G. Model Homes. No Owner of any Lot shall build or permit the building upon his Lot of any dwelling house that is to be used as a model home or exhibit house without permission to do so from the Declarant.
- H. Temporary Structures. No temporary house, trailer, tent, garage or other outbuilding shall be placed or erected on any Lot, nor shall any overnight camping be parmitted on any Lot.
- I. <u>Ditches and Swales</u>. It shall be the duty of every Owner of every Lot on which any part of an open storm drainage ditch or swale is situated to keep such portion thereof as may be situated upon his Lot continuously unobstructed (both by improvements and plant material) and in good repair, and to provide for the installation of such culverts upon said lot as may be reusonably necessary to accomplish the purposes of this supparagraph I.
- J. Utility Services. Utility services shall, to the greatest extect possible be installed underground and in it adjacent to public rights-of-way to minimize removal of or damage to trees.
- K. Wells and Septic Tanks. No water wells shall be drilled on any of the Lots, nor shall any septic tanks or other sewage disposal systems be installed on any of the Lota, without the approval of the Committee and of the governing public health agency or other civil authority.

Section 6. Committee's Functions.

A. Statement of Purposes and Powers. The Committee shall regulate the exterior design, appearance, use, location and maintenance of lands subject to these Restrictions, and improvements thereon, in such a manner as to preserve and enhance values, to maintain a harmonious relationship among structures and the natural vegetation and topography, and to provide for the proper functioning of the storm drainage system for the Real Estate. For these purposes, the Committee may, from time to time and at any time, make, amend and modify such rules, regulations and

quidelines as it may deem necessary or desirable to guide Owners as to the terms, conditions, procedures and requirements of the Committee for the submission and approval of items to it. Soor rules, regulations and guidelines may, in admittable, set forth additional appendituations to those set forth herein or in any subdivision plats of the Real Estate, so long as the same are not inconsistent with this Declaration or any such subdivision plat.

- No dwelling, building, structure or other (1) Generally. improvement of any type or kind shall be constructed. placed, repaired, remodeled, reconstructed or altered on more about only work the books on only had which alters or openions the frame or sistation thereof. the prior approval of the Committee. Such approval shall be obtained only after written application has been made to the Committee by the Owner of the Lot requesting authorization from the Committee. Such written application shall be made in the manner and form prescribed from time to time by the Committee, and shall be accompanied by two (1) complete sets of plans and specifications for any such proposed construction, improvement and other work. Such plans shall include plot plans showing the location of all improvements existing upon the Lot and the location of the improvement proposed to be constructed, placed, repaired, remodeled, reconstructed or altered upon the Lor, each properly and clearly designated. Such plans and specifications shall set forth the color and composition of all exterior materials proposed to be used and any proposed (and existing) landscaping, together with any other material or information which the Committee may require. All building plans and drawings required to be submitted to the Committee shall be drawn to a scale of 1 4 "" and all plot plans shall be drawn to a scale of 1 "30", or to such other scale as the Committee shall require. There shall also be submitted, where applicable, such other permits or reports as may be required under this Declaration. The following drawings shall be considered atolinum tor approval acudy:
 - (a) Site plan which includes complete topographic study, location of all trees, existing and proposed structures, drives, proposed (or existing) sanitary snwage disposal system location, utility service, storm drainage and grading details, terraces and all landscape details (including size of all plantings and type); and
 - (b) Foundation plan, floor plans, cross-sections, exterior elevations, and complete specifications for all materials to be used on the exterior of the house, building, structure or other improvement.
- (ii) Power of Disapproval. The Committee may refuse to grant permission to construct, place or make the requested improvement, or to perform other work, when:
