The Child labor Survey of the State of New York has been organized by the State Education Department, and designated as the State Bureau of Child Labor Survey. The State Board of Regents of the State University of New York has appointed the Directors of the Bureau, and the Bureau will be under the supervision of the State Board of Regents. The Bureau will be organized to study the social, industrial, and educational conditions of the State, and to make recommendations for the improvement of the same. The Bureau will be erected as an independent organization, and will be subject to the control of the State Board of Regents. The Bureau will have the right to explore all the business organizations in the State, and to report generally by means of local agents. The Bureau will be independent of the State Board of Regents, and will be responsible to the State Board of Regents for its actions.
