

MASTER DECLARATION OF GOVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS SOUTH LAKE FOR

A RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT IN GREENWOOD, INDIANA

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South Lake Section Two ("The Preserve") comprising Lots 54 to 101, imposes the following plat restrictions and covenants on the Subdivision for the benefit of all present and future Owners (as hereinafter defined) of any Lot in the Subdivision. Each Owner shall maintain such portion of any utility or drainage easement area as is located upon such Owner's Lot.
