DEFLARATION DE COURANTS AND RESTRICTIONS

THIS DECLARATION, made this And day of November, 1994, by Pine Blues, Overlook Corporation, an Indiana corporation, thereinafter referred to as the "Developer"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Developer is the owner of all the lands contained in the area shown on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereos, which lands will be subdivided and known as SUMMERFIELD - SUSTION ONE (hereinafter referred to as the "Davelogment"), and still be more particularly described on the plat thereof which will be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Hamilton County; and

WHEREAS, the leveloper is about to sell and convey the residential lots situated within the platted areas of the Development and, before doing so, desires to subject and impose upon all real settate within the platted areas of the Development matual and beneficial restrictions, covenants, conditions and charges (hereinatter referred to as the "Restrictions") under a general plen or scheme of improvement for the benefit of the lots end lands in the Development and the future owners thereof;

NOW, THEREBORE, the Developer hereby declares that all of the platted lote and lands located within the Development as they become platted are held, and shall be held, conveyed, hypothecated or encombered, leased, remied, used, occupied and improved, subject to the following hestriotians, all of which are declared and agreed to be in furtherence of a plan for the improvement and sale of said lots and lands in the Development, and are strabilished and agreed upon for the purpose of chimacing and protecting the value, desirability and attractiveness of the Development as a whole and of each of said lots situated therein. All of the Exercictions chall run with the Land and shall be binding upon the Development and upon the perites having an interest in and to the real property or any part or parts thereof subject to such Restrictions, and shall inmre to the benefit of the Developer and every one of the Developer's subject is successors in the level search in the law lose successors the title to any real estate so shown as described in Exhibit "A" from the Evelopment, or to include additional real setters. of the Developer's successors

ESCHITIONS. The following are the definitions of the terms as they are used in this Declaration:

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- "Committee" shall mean the Summerfield Architectural Review Committee, composed of three (3) members appointed by the Leveloper, who shall be subject to removal by the Leveloper at my time, with or without cause. Any vacancies, from time to time, shall be filled by appointment of the Developer. The Developer may, at its sole option, at any time hereafter, relinguish to the Association the
- "Association" shall mean the dummerfield Property Owner's Association, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, the membraces of which are more fully described in paragraph is mbership and 3 of this
- "Lot" shall mean any parcel of residential real estate described by the plat of the Development which is recorded in the office of the Recorder of Hamilton County, Indiana.
- "Owner" shall mean a person, partnership, trust or comporation who has or is acquiring any right, title or inverest, legal or equitable, in and to a lot, but excluding those persons having such interest merely as security for the performance of an obligation.

- E. "Town" shari mean the Town of Fishers, Hamilton County. Indiana.
- i. "Plat' shall mean the subdivision plat of the property. As the same may be hereinaiter amended or supplemented pursuant to this beclaration.

2. CHARACIES OF THE DEVELOPMENT

- A. In denotal, Every numbered for platted as a part of the Development shall be for residential purposes. No structure shall be erected, placed or remaited to remain upon any of said residential lots except a single-family dealling house. No double occupancy dealing shall be refruitted on any part of the Development. All tracts of land located within the levelopment which have not been designated by numbering as residential baliding lots in the recorded plat shall be used in a manner consistent with the coning and use designated in the plan filed by the Leveloper with the Peparument of Community Development in the form of Fishers. However, the Developer reserves unto lusel the right to change the character of such designated use, at any time in the fature, by applying to the Fishers Plan Commission and its staff for modifications of the plan, and, where necessary to apply to any other necessary governmental body for such reclassification, rezoning or variance of use needed to accommodate the Developer's planned use.
- B. We Storage Shede. Nornithstanding anything contained herein or in the krticles or Ey-Laws to the contrary, and in addition to all restrictions set forth in the plat of the bevelopment, any and all forms of sheds, storage sheds, large animal quarters, etc., which are intended to not be directly connected to the main house on any Lot are hereby strictly prohibited unless, on a case-by-case beals, the Owners shall approve of such additional haliding by a seventy-five percent (75%) majority of all Owners at a meeting of the Owners called for the purpose of approving such building or at the annual meeting.
- Commence or Residential Use of Partially Completed Desiling House Evolution. We dealing house constructed on any of the residential lots shall be occupied or used for residential purposes or human habitation until it has been substantially completed.
- D. Cher Restrictions. All tracts of ground in the Development shall be subject to the easements, restrictions and limitations of record appearing on the recorded plat of the subdivision, on recorded easements, rights-of-way, and also to all governmental zoning authorities and regulations affecting the Development, all of which are incorporated herein by reference.
- RESTRICTIONS CONCREMING SIZE, PLACTIFIET AND MAINTENANCE OF IMELLING HOUSES AND OTHER STRUCTURES.
- A. Hinimum Living Error Access. The minimum square footoge of living space of dwellings consequenced on various residential love in the bevelopment, exclusive of porches, terroces, garages, carports or similar recilities shall be a minimum of 1,200 square feet for one-errory dwellings or 1,400 square feet for multi-level dwellings. Becoments shall not be included in the comparation of the minimum living area, except for that portion of a walkout baccment which is to be finished as a living area.
- B. Regidential Development Requirements and Standards.
- The minimum lot area for any lot within the subdivision shall be five thousand five hundred (5,500) square feet.

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- (ii) The minimum lot width at the Guilding set-back line on any lot shall be fifty five (55) feet.
- (iii) The minimum lot depth on any lot will be one hundred (100) feet.
- (lv) Front Set-Backs. Unless otherwise provided in these Restrictions or on the recorded plat, all dwelling houses and above-grade structures shall be constructed or placed on residential lots in the Development so as to comply with the set-back lines, as established on the plat of the Development.
- (v) Side Yards. The side yard set-back lines shall not be less than six (6) feet from the side line of the lot unless approved by the Committee and the Fishers Board of Zoning Appeals.
- (vi) Rear Yards. Unless otherwise provided in these Restrictions or on the recorded plat, all dwelling houses and above-grade structures shall be constructed or placed on residential lots in the Development so as to comply with the ser-back lines, as established on the plat of the Development.
- (vii) Lot coverage of any home shall not exceed forty percent (40%) of the total lot square footage.
- (viii) Sach lot, when built upon, will provide for a minimum of two (2) off street parking spaces.

C. Rences. Mailboxes and Tress.

In order to preserve the natural quality and assidetic appearance of the existing geographic areas within the Development, all fences must be approved by the Committee as to size, location, height and composition before they may be installed. No chain link fence will be permitted.

To maintain the integrity of Delaware Parkway in regard to preserving green belt areas, no rear yard fencing will be permitted in the back yards adjacent to Delaware Farkway, more specifically on low numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 57, 56, 59, 60 and 61.

- (11) 4 uniform mailbox and post design will be selected by the byweloger for all lots within the bevelogment. All mailboxes will be installed by the builder of each single family home on each individual lot.
- (111) A lot must have at least one (1) tree growing upon it in the front yard by the time the house is completed, weather permitting. Such tree shall not be less than two inches (2" in diameter.
- EXECUTE CONSTRUCTION. The finished exterior of every building constructed or placed on any lot in the Development shall be of material other than tar paper, relibric, siding or any other similar material. All driverage must be paved with concrete.
- in the case of a corner lot, the front yard and any side yard with street frontage must be sodded, at the time the house is completed, weather permitting.

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- F. Quighds Lighting. Every house in the development must have at least two (2) coach lights on the exterior of each garage area with such lighting isoing the street frontage. These coach lights will be controlled by a photocell to provide dusk-to-dawn lighting.
- d. SideBalks. The builder of each building constructed on any lot will be responsible for the construction of all public walks along the street frontage and for any private eigenalis for each house.
- H. Marages Required. All residential dwellings in the Development shall include at least a two-car enclosed garage. Detached garages are not permitted.
- figating Planta. Every house in the Tevelopment must contain a heating plant, installed in compliance with the required codes, and capable of providing adequate heat for year-round human habitation of the house.
- J. Dillegace in Construction. Every building whose construction or placement on any residential lot in the Development is began shall be completed within nine (3) months after the beginning of such construction or placement. We improvement which has partially or totally been destroyed by fire or otherwise shall be allowed to remain in such state for more than three (3) months from the time of such destruction or descape.
- K. iales of Lots by Leveloper. Every lot within the Development shall be sold to a builder approved by the Developer or developed by the Developer.
- L. <u>Prohibition of Used Structures</u>. All structures constructed or placed on any numbered lot in the Development shall be constructed with substantially all new materials and no used structures shall be relocated or placed on any such lot.
- It. Shingles. All houses within the bevelopment shall have shingles which are of the same color, such color being weathered wood or its egual and shall be approved by the Committee.
- N. Colors. The Committee will approve all colors of brick, stone, siding and trim to be used by the Builder of any house within the fevelopment, and the Committee must approve any color changes any owner wishes to make at the time of remodeling or regaining.
- v. Maintenance of Lora and improvements. The Owner of any lot in the Development shall, at all times, maintain the lot and any improvements situated thereon in such a manner as to prevent the lot or improvements from becoming unsightly and, specifically, such there shall:

- (11) Remove all debris and rubbish.
- (iii) Prevent the existence of any other condition that reasonably tends to detract from or diminish the seatheric appearance of the Development.

- (Iv) Neither the form of Fishers nor any public utility or other properly authorized user of the form's property located between the street and the stdewalk and/or right-oi-way easement line shall be liable to the owner of the dominant real estate for any damages done to trees or shrubs located upon form property between the street and the stdewalk and/or right-pi-way easement line as a result of actions of the form of fishers or any nuclic utility or other authorized user or their agents or employees in the performance of their duties.

- A. Untitle Toilets. No outside toilets shall be permitted on any ist in the Teve Orment (except during a Feriod of construction).
- Construction of Senses when all sanitary sever lines on the residential building lots shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the provisions and requirements of the Town of Fishers. Indiana, Mo storm water (subsurface or surface) shall be discharged into sanitary sewere.

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C. LOCATION of SANITARY SENER MARKETS. SANITARY SEVER MEMORIES SHALL NOT be placed under or within one (1) foot norizontally of pavement including driveways or sidewalks.

5. MENEFAL PROHIBITIONS.

- à. In <u>Sangral</u> No noxious or offensive activities shall be permitted on any lot in the bevelopment, nor shall caything be done on any of said lots that shall become or be an unreasonable annoyance or nuisance to any Gamer of another lot in the Development.
- B. <u>Signs.</u> No signs or advertisements shall be displayed or placed on any lot or structures in the Development, except entry signs and home or lot sales signs, without the approval of the Developer.
- C. Animals. We enimals shall be kept or maintained on any lot in the fevel-papent except the usual household pets and, in such cose, such household pets shall be kept reasonably confined so as not to become a misance. However, no dog runs and/or dog kennels shall be permitted in the Development.
- i. Vehicle Parking. No trucks one (1) ton or larger in size, campers, trailers, bosts, bost trailers or similar vehicles shall be parked on any street in the fewelogment. Any motor or recreational vehicle, trailer, camper, bost or bost trailer which is not used for normal transportation shall not be permitted to remain on any lot except within a closed garage and shall not be regularly parked upon unpaved areas.
- E. Harbare and Other Refuse. No Owner of a lot in the Development shall burn or permit the burning out-of-doors of garbage or other refuse, nor shall any such Owner accumulates or permit the accumulation out-of-doors of such refuse on his lot except as may be permitted in subparagraph & below. All houses built in the Levelopment shall be equipped with a garbage disposal unit.
- F. Ruel Storage Tanks and Trash Receptacles. Every tank for the storage of thel that is installed outside any building in the levelopment shall be buried below the surface of the ground. Every outdoor receptacle for ashes, trash, rubbish or garrage shall be installed underground or shall be so placed and kept as not to be visible from any street within the Bevelopment at any time, except at the times when refuse collections are being made.
- G. Model Homes. No owner of any lot in the Development shall build or permit the building upon said lot of any dwelling house that is to be used as a model home without permission to do so from the Developer.
- H. Ismcorary Structures. No temporary house, trailer, tent, garage or other outbuilding shall be placed or erected on any lot without the approval of the leveloper.
- iren brainage, fitches and dwales.
- the right-of-way, or on dedicated readways and within the right-of-way, or on dedicated dreatuage easements, are not to be altered, dug out, filled in, tiled or otherwise changed, without the written recruission of the Town Engineer. Froperty owners must maintain these swales as sodden, grassways or other non-eroding surfaces. Water from roofs or parking areas must be contained on the property long enough so that said drainage swales or divokes will not be damaged by such water. Interways may be constructed over these

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swares or ditches only when appropriate-sized culverts or other approved structures have seen fermitted by the Town angineer.

Culverts must be protected, especially at the ends, by head walls or metal end sections, and, if damaged enough to retard the water flow, must be replaced.

- (11) Any property owner attering, changing or damaging these trainings smales or disches will be held responsible for such action and will be given ten (10) days notice, by registered mail, to repair said damage, after which time, if no action is taken, the Toom will cause said repairs to be accomplished and the bill for such repairs will be sent to diffected and the bill for such repairs will be sent to the sifected property owners for immediate payment.
- j. Utility Services. Essenents for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved as shown on the recorded plat.
- K. Hells and Servic Tanks. No water wells shall be drilled on any of the loss (other than for hearing or cooling purposes) for shall any servic tanks be installed on any of the loss in the Leveloyment, unless public tap-in to a senitary sewer system is unevailable.
- i. Obrushive Chiecta. No high intensity lighting, no television, radic or other entenmae, no large satellite dishes, nor any visually obrushive object may be erected by any lot Charles not the exterior of a dhelling or anythere on a lot unless approved by the Committee. It is the intent not to allow any exterior antenmae. The Committee reserves the right to review that mechanisms and equipment are permitted based upon the changes in technology.

It is also the intent to permit small (is or less in dismeter) satellite dishes to be installed with such installation and location of installation on the house to be approved by the committee.

- M. Moror whicks. The revair or storage of inoperative motor vehicles or material alteration of motor vehicles snail not be permitted on a lot unless entirely within a garage permitted to be constructed by these coverants and restrictions.
- N. Hoata and Recreational Vehicles. No boat, trailer or comper of any kind shall be kept on parked upon a lot except within the garage.
- hove Ground Pools. No above ground pools, except for small kiddle pools, shall be allowed in the Develorment.
- i. Extructions. We fence, wall, hedge, tree, shrub planting or other obstruction shall be placed in a triangular epace at the street corner of a corner lot which would obstruct vision between the heights of three (3) and theire (12) feet above established street grade, determined by a diagonal line connecting the points measured 25 feet equidistance from the street corner along each property line.
- Q. Enilding Height. All lots in the Development shall be designated as residential lots, and no home shall exceed two and one half: 5 1/2; stories or thirty five (35) feet in height.

6. ELEMENTE.

.. Lots are subject to drainage easements, sewer easements, utility easements, landscare maintenance easements and non-access easements, either separately or in combination of the five, as snown on the

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yiat of the fevelogment maion are reserved for the use of the lotowners, suchic utility companies and governmental agencies as follows:

- (i) Inhings easements (U.E. are created to provide paths and courses for area and local storm drainage, either overland or in adequate underground conduit. to serve the needs of the levelogment and adjoining ground and/or public orainage aystem, under no dircumrances shall said easements be blocked, in any manner, by the construction or reconstruction of any improvement, nor shall any grading restrict the mater flow in any manner. Said areas are subject to construction or reconstruction to any satisfareas are subject to obtain adequate drainage at any time by any governmental anthority having jurisdiction over drainage or by the leveloper.
- (ii) Storm sever easements (5.E.) and sanitary sever easements (5.S.E.) are created for the use of the local governmental agency having jurisdiction over the storm and/or sanitary waste disposal system of said city and/or county designated serve the addition for the purposes of installation and maintenance of severs that are a part of said system. As part of the 5.S.E., it is understood the form of fishers has ingress and egress rights to these easements to provide for maintenance of sanitary sever. Each owner of a lot must connect with public sanitary sever.
- (iii) Utility easements (U.S.) are created for the use of public utility and cable television companies, not including transportation companies, for the installation of pipes, mains, ducts and caples, as well as for the uses specified in the case of sewer easements.
- (iv) ionidecate maintenance easements (L.M.E.) and sign iandecase easements (S.L.K.) are created for the use of the Assentation, subject to the rights of the 'oners as set forth in this Declaration, and the Association shall be responsible for the management, control and maintenance of the same in good, clean, attractive, sare and sanitary condition, order and repair.
- (V) Non-access easements (N.A.K.) are created to prohibit direct access to public rights-of-way of 198th Street and/or Felamare Parkway.
- (vi) The Gamers of all lots in the Development shail take title subject to the rights of public utilities, governmental agencies and the rights of the other lot owners in the Development to said essements been granted for ingress and egress in, along and through the strips of ground for the purposes herein stated.
- . LAKE COMMON ARRA NO. 1.. VARIABLE D.E., L.H.E., COMMON AREA NO. 2 AND COMMON AREA NO. 2
- In There are identified on the plat of the Development areas to be owned by the Association with one such area designated as Lake Commondate No. 1 which comprises a retention found designed to accommodate storm water desirage runoff from the development and adjoining real estate. The area identified as Lake Common area No. I shall be conveyed by the Developer to the Association.

- Gertain Ublications and Access Kichta to the Lake Common area No.
- (1) Except as otherwise set forth in this Feclaration, the Association, subject to the rights of the Owners as set forth in this Feclaration, shall be responsible for the management, control and maintenance, for the exclusive benefit of the Univers as provided herein, of the Lake Common Areas No. 1 in a safe, neat and orderly condition at all times.
- (ii) The Association shall have and is hereby granted a general right of soceas and easement to all of the Lake Common Area, No. 1 across the lots adjoining said lake, at reasonable times and at any time in the case of an emergency, as and their secure and independent contractors, employees, and their secure and independent contractors, to the rull extent necessary or appropriate to perform its obligatione and trights specified herein also are reserved for the benefit of the Eveloper so long as the Developer owns any portion of the development and for so long as the Developer may be responsible for any marranty work.

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- (111) An elabelment is hereby dedicated and granted for the use, in the case of an emergency, of emergency vehicles, including, but not limited to, fire trucks, police care and ambulances and of emergency personnel, public and private, over and upon the Lake Common Area No. 1 owned by the Association and the adjoining lote.
- C. Use of Lake Common area No. 1.
- (1) Except as otherwise provided herein, the enjoyment of the bake Common area No. 1 shall be limited to the owners of the lote adjusting the Lake Common area No. 1 as shown on the plat.
- (11) Except for the rights of the Daveloper, the Association, and their employees, heirs, successors and assigns, se set forth in this Declaration, no individual shall have the right to cross a lot other than his own for access to the Lake common area No. 1.
- (iii) No one shall commant or Fermit any action or activity which could result in pollution of the lakes, diversion of Rater. elevation of lake level, earth disturbance resulting in silting or any other conduct which could result in an adverse effect upon water quality, drainage or proper lake management except as provided in this leclaration. The lake may not be used for swimming, fishing, boating or for any other purpose, except for drainage of the feedbranent, unless allowed by law and expressly and specifically approved by the Association and so stated, in writing, by the Board of Directors.

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- D. Use of Common area rio. . and common area rio. a.
- (1) within these areas are sideralks which the public has the right to use as if they were gooded within the public right-of-way.
- 5. LANDSCAPE MAINTSNAME EASEMENTS (LLEER) SIGN LANDSCAPE EASEMENTS (S.L.E.), LAKE COMON AREA NO. 1... COMBON AREA NO. 2 AND COMBON AREA NO. 3.
- A. The Association, as part of its duties and as part of the Association's expenses, shall provide for:
- (1) Maintenance of the L.M.R.'s, S.L.R.'s, Lake Common area No. 1, Common area, No. 2 and Common Area, No. 3. Maintenance shall include, but shall not be limited to, fertilizing, moving and replanting, when necessary. of the grass and trees, and maintenance of any other improvements within these areas except for sidewalks which may installed within Common Area No. 2 and Common Area No. 3. respectively. Such sidewalks are public eldewalks and, once installed by the Powerloper, shall be maintained by the Torn of Fishers,
- (ii) Maintenance of the entry eigns and walls, the perimeter landscaping and any perimeter Tencing installed by the Developer.
- (iii) All manner of erosion control, bank stabilization and chemical treatments with respect to the lake common area No. 1.
- E. The Board of Directors may adopt such other rules and regulations concerning maintenance, repair, use and enjoyment of the LH.E. a. S.L.H. of a. Lake Common Area No. 1, Common Area No. 2 and Common Area No. 3 as it deems necessary.

9. PERIMETER LANDSCAPE RASEMENT ALONG WEST PROPERTY LINE.

- I. There exists or will exist a thenty foot (20') landscare essement wherent to the vectors property line of the bevelopment. Such landscape essement contains white vinyl fenoing, tree plantings and a grass area. The Association, as part of its duties and as part of the Association's expense, shall provide for:
- i) Maintenance of this landscape easement and such meintenance shall include, but shall not be limited to, fertilizing, moving and replanting, when necessary, of the grass and trees and maintenance of the fencing within this landscape easement.

10. EXPANSION.

Property Subject to Expansion by the Eeveloper. The Developer reserves the right to expand the amount of property subject to this Declaration, as emended from time to time, without the consent of the Owners, or any other party.

11. ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE.

6. Elalement of Europea and Ponera. The Committee shall regulate the external design, appearance, use, location and maintenance of lands and improvements subject to these fiestrictions in such a manner as

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v. preserve and enhance values and to maintain a harmonious relationship among structures and the natural vegetation and topography.

Such plans and excitications shall set forth the color and composition of all exterior materials proposed to be used and any proposed landscaping, together with any other materials or information which the Committee may require. All building plans and drawings required to be submitted to the committee shall be drawn to a scale of 1" = 30" or to such other scale as the Committee shall require.
- (ii) Four of Disapproval. The Committee may refuse to great permission to construct, place or make the requested improvement, when:
- (4) The plane, opecifications, drawings or other material submitted are themselves inadequate or incomplete, or show the proposed improvement to be in violation of these Kegrriotions;
- (b) The design or color scheme of a proposed improvement is not in harmony with the general surroundings of the lot or with adjacent buildings or structures;
- (c) The proposed improvement, or any part hereof, would, in the sole opinion and absolute discretion of the Committee, be contrary to the increase, welfare or rights of all or any portion of owners.

- D. Inspection. The Committee may inspect work being retriormed with its permission to assure compalance with these Restrictions and applicable regulations.
- 6. Continuation of Committee. At such time that the feveloper notified the Association in writing that it is relinquishing its memberships on the Committee, then the Directors of the Association, or their designees, shall continue the functions of the Committee with like powers.
- F. Brilder Approved Flans. Prior to any construction start, any builder who builds in the Evelopment shall submit any and all building plans it proposes to build in the Evelopment to the Eveloper for written approval. Once the Eveloper provides written approval to the builder that such plants) has thave, been approved, the builder shall be remaitted to build such plants throughout the term of its contractual agreement with Eveloper to purchase lots in the Evelopment without further submission to the Eveloper and/or any Architectural Review Committee.
- 12. WHEE COVERNING BUILDING ON EXVERSE CONTIGUOUS LOTS HAVING ONE CHARK. - (iv) The Association may contract for such service as management, smoot removal, sociality control, how sh removal and such other services as the Association deems necessary or advisable.
